## HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 39

A bill to amend 1998 PA 386, entitled "Estates and protected individuals code," by amending section 2801 (MCL 700.2801), as amended by 2016 PA 57.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2801. (1) An individual who is divorced from the decedent
- 2 or whose marriage to the decedent has been annulled is not a
- 3 surviving spouse unless, by virtue of a subsequent marriage, he or
- 4 she is married to the decedent at the time of death. A decree of
- 5 separation that does not terminate the status of husband and wife
- 6 MARRIED COUPLE is not a divorce for purposes of this section.
- 7 (2) For purposes of parts 1 to 4 of this article and of
- 8 section 3203, a surviving spouse does not include any of the
- 9 following:
- 10 (a) An individual who obtains or consents to a final decree or

- 1 judgment of divorce from the decedent or an annulment of their
- 2 marriage, which decree or judgment is not recognized as valid in
- 3 this state, unless they subsequently participate in a marriage
- 4 ceremony purporting to marry each to the other or live together as
- 5 husband and wife. A MARRIED COUPLE.
- 6 (b) An individual who, following an invalid decree or judgment
- 7 of divorce or annulment obtained by the decedent, participates in a
- 8 marriage ceremony with a third individual.
- 9 (c) An individual who was a party to a valid proceeding
- 10 concluded by an order purporting to terminate all marital property
- 11 rights.
- 12 (d) An individual who, at the time of the decedent's death, is
- 13 living in a bigamous relationship with another individual.
- 14 (e) An individual who did any of the following for 1 year or
- 15 more before the death of the deceased person:
- 16 (i) Was willfully absent from the decedent spouse.
- 17 (ii) Deserted the decedent spouse.
- 18 (iii) Willfully neglected or refused to provide support for
- 19 the decedent spouse if required to do so by law.
- 20 (3) For purposes of section 3206, a surviving spouse does not
- 21 include either of the following:
- 22 (a) An individual described in subsection (2).(2)(A) TO (D).
- 23 (b) An individual who is a party to a divorce or annulment
- 24 proceeding with the decedent at the time of the decedent's death.
