- 1 Sec. 175. Any person duly AN INDIVIDUAL elected to the office
- 2 of state senator or representative who desires to resign shall file
- 3 a written notice containing the effective date of such THE
- 4 resignation with the presiding officer of his OR HER respective
- 5 house, who shall immediately transmit the same WRITTEN NOTICE to
