SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4319

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 803f (MCL 257.803f), as amended by 1998 PA 68.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 803f. (1) A person who is a totally disabled veteran with
- 2 an honorable discharge from the armed services may make an
- 3 application to the secretary of state if he or she owns a private
- 4 passenger motor vehicle, and the secretary of state may issue a
- 5 special registration plate which shall be inscribed with special
- 6 identification numbers preceded by the letters "DV" and shall have
- 7 the words "disabled veteran" inscribed beneath the registration
- 8 number. For the purposes of this section, "private passenger motor
- 9 vehicle" means a motor vehicle which THAT is personally owned by
- 10 the disabled veteran and is used for the primary purpose of

- 1 transporting the disabled veteran and family members of the
- 2 disabled veteran, but does not include a motor home.
- 3 (2) Application for the special registration plate shall MUST
- 4 be on a form prescribed by the secretary of state , and shall MUST
- 5 be accompanied by a service fee of \$5.00 and proof that the
- 6 applicant was honorably discharged from the armed services and
- 7 either 1 of the following:
- 8 (a) That the applicant has been determined by the veterans'
- 9 administration of the federal government UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT
- 10 OF VETERANS AFFAIRS to have a service-connected total or permanent
- 11 total disability rating for compensation.
- 12 (b) That the applicant has been determined to have a service-
- 13 connected total or permanent total disability rating and is
- 14 receiving disability retirement pay from a branch of the uniformed
- 15 armed services.
- 16 (3) A special registration issued under this section is exempt
- 17 from payment of the tax provided in section 801.
- 18 (4) The special registration plate shall expire EXPIRES on the
- 19 birthday of the disabled veteran in a year in which new plates are
- 20 issued by the secretary of state. Application for renewal of the
- 21 special registration plate shall MUST be accompanied by a \$5.00
- 22 service fee. The applicant shall not be required to furnish the
- 23 proof provided in subsection (2).
- 24 (5) THE SURVIVING SPOUSE OF A PERSON WHO IS A TOTALLY DISABLED
- 25 VETERAN WITH AN HONORABLE DISCHARGE FROM THE ARMED SERVICES MAY USE
- 26 A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION AFTER THE
- 27 DEATH OF THE TOTALLY DISABLED VETERAN. A SURVIVING SPOUSE WHO

- 1 WISHES TO USE A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE ISSUED UNDER THIS
- 2 SECTION SHALL NOTIFY THE SECRETARY OF STATE THAT HE OR SHE WISHES
- 3 TO USE THE PLATE NO LATER THAN 15 DAYS AFTER THE DEATH OF THE
- 4 TOTALLY DISABLED VETERAN OR, IF APPLICABLE, WITHIN THE 15-DAY
- 5 PERIOD DESCRIBED IN SECTION 234. EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN
- 6 THIS SUBSECTION, FOR THE FIRST YEAR AFTER NOTIFYING THE SECRETARY
- 7 OF STATE OF HIS OR HER INTENT TO USE THE PLATE, THE SURVIVING
- 8 SPOUSE MAY RENEW THE PLATE WITHOUT HAVING TO PAY THE APPLICABLE
- 9 REGISTRATION TAX PROVIDED IN SECTION 801. BEGINNING WITH THE SECOND
- 10 YEAR AFTER A SURVIVING SPOUSE NOTIFIES THE SECRETARY OF STATE OF
- 11 HIS OR HER INTENT TO USE A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE ISSUED UNDER
- 12 THIS SECTION, THE SURVIVING SPOUSE SHALL PAY THE APPLICABLE
- 13 REGISTRATION TAX PROVIDED IN SECTION 801 AND IS SUBJECT TO ANNUAL
- 14 RENEWAL OF HIS OR HER REGISTRATION AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 226. IF
- 15 APPLICABLE, A SURVIVING SPOUSE SHALL APPLY FOR REGISTRATION OF THE
- 16 VEHICLE UPON WHICH HE OR SHE WISHES TO PLACE THE DISABLED VETERAN
- 17 PLATE BEFORE USING OR RENEWING THE PLATE AS DESCRIBED IN THIS
- 18 SECTION. IF A SURVIVING SPOUSE HAS PAID THE APPLICABLE REGISTRATION
- 19 TAX FOR HIS OR HER VEHICLE FOR THE YEAR IN WHICH HE OR SHE NOTIFIES
- 20 THE SECRETARY OF STATE OF HIS OR HER INTENT TO USE A SPECIAL
- 21 REGISTRATION PLATE ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, THE 1-YEAR PERIOD
- 22 DURING WHICH THE SURVIVING SPOUSE MAY RENEW THE PLATE WITHOUT
- 23 PAYMENT OF THE APPLICABLE REGISTRATION TAX BEGINS ON THE DATE HIS
- 24 OR HER CURRENT REGISTRATION EXPIRES.
- **25 (6)** (5) The secretary of state may issue to a disabled person
- 26 who has been issued a special registration plate under this section
- 27 a tab for persons with disabilities. The tab for persons with

- 1 disabilities shall MUST be an adhesive tab displaying the
- 2 international wheelchair symbol or a reasonable facsimile of that
- 3 symbol. The tab for persons with disabilities may be attached only
- 4 to the special registration plate issued to the disabled person
- 5 under this section.
- 6 (7) (6) An application for a tab for persons with disabilities
- 7 shall be on a form prescribed by the secretary of state. The
- 8 secretary of state shall require the same proof that the applicant
- 9 is a disabled person as is required for issuance of a permanent
- 10 windshield placard under section 675. IF THE SURVIVING SPOUSE OF A
- 11 TOTALLY DISABLED VETERAN IS A DISABLED PERSON, HE OR SHE MAY APPLY
- 12 TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR A TAB FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES
- 13 IN THE SAME MANNER AS PROVIDED FOR A TOTALLY DISABLED VETERAN UNDER
- 14 THIS SUBSECTION.
- 15 (8) $\frac{(7)}{}$ The tab for persons with disabilities shall MUST be
- 16 issued free of charge.
- (9) (8) When a disabled person who has been issued a tab for
- 18 persons with disabilities renews his or her special registration
- 19 plate under this section, the secretary of state shall issue a new
- 20 tab for persons with disabilities to the disabled person, free of
- 21 charge. The disabled person shall not be required to again furnish
- 22 the proof required under subsection $\frac{(6)}{(7)}$.
- 23 (10) (9)—The use of the special registration plate or a tab
- 24 for persons with disabilities on a motor vehicle other than the
- 25 motor vehicle for which the special registration plate is issued,
- 26 or by a person who does not qualify under this section, is a
- 27 misdemeanor.
