SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4749

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law,"

by amending section 254 (MCL 168.254), as amended by 2018 PA 120.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 254. (1) To obtain the printing of the name of a person 1 as a candidate for nomination by a political party for the office 2 3 of county road commissioner under a particular party heading upon the official primary ballots, there must be filed with the county 4 5 clerk of the county nominating petitions signed by a number of 6 qualified and registered electors residing within the county as determined under section 544f. Nominating petitions must be in the 7 form prescribed in section 544c. The county clerk shall receive 8 9 nominating petitions up to 4 p.m. of the fifteenth Tuesday before

- 1 the August primary in which county road commissioners are to be
- 2 elected.
- 3 (2) To obtain the printing of the name of a candidate of a
- 4 political party under the particular party's heading upon the
- 5 primary election ballots in the various voting precincts of the
- 6 county, there may be filed by each candidate, in lieu of filing
- 7 nominating petitions, a NONREFUNDABLE filing fee of \$100.00 to be
- 8 paid to the county clerk. Payment of the fee and certification of
- 9 the name of the candidate paying the fee are governed by the same
- 10 provisions as in the case of nominating petitions. The fee must be
- 11 deposited in the general fund of the county. and must be returned
- 12 to all candidates who are nominated and to an equal number of
- 13 candidates who received the next highest number of votes in the
- 14 primary election. If 2 or more candidates tie in having the lowest
- 15 number of votes allowing a refund, the sum of \$100.00 must be
- 16 divided among them. The deposits of all other defeated candidates,
- 17 as well as the deposits of candidates who withdraw or are
- 18 disqualified, are forfeited and the candidates must be notified of
- 19 the forfeitures. Deposits forfeited under this section must be paid
- 20 into and credited to the general fund of the county.
- 21 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 22 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 23 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
