HOUSE BILL No. 4940

September 13, 2017, Introduced by Reps. Canfield, Lucido, Barrett, Victory, Sheppard, Alexander and Roberts and referred to the Committee on Agriculture.

A bill to amend 1965 PA 114, entitled

"An act relating to dry, edible beans; to create a bean commission and prescribe its functions; to levy and collect assessments on bean production; and to provide penalties for violation of this act,"

by amending sections 1, 2, 3, and 4 (MCL 290.551, 290.552, 290.553, and 290.554), as amended by 2000 PA 484.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
 - (a) "Beans" means Michigan dry, edible beans, except soybeans.
 - (b) "Commission" means the Michigan bean commission.
 - (c) "Director" means the director of the department of agriculture AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT.
 - (d) "Grower" means any business unit, including a family operation, sole proprietorship, partnership, corporation, company, association, trust, or other business organization engaged in the

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- 1 business of producing beans for sale within 1 of the past 3 years.
- 2 (e) "Processor" means a person who THAT cleans and grades,
- 3 dries, dehydrates, cans, powders, extracts, cooks, or uses in
- 4 producing or manufacturing a product or article, ships, or
- 5 otherwise handles beans, including seed.
- 6 (F) "SELECTION MEMBERS" MEANS THE COMMISSION MEMBERS SELECTED
- 7 AND APPOINTED FOR EACH DISTRICT CREATED UNDER SECTION 2 AND THE
- 8 PROCESSOR SHIPPER HANDLER MEMBER SELECTED AND APPOINTED UNDER
- 9 SECTION 4(2).
- 10 (G) (f)—"Sold or shipped for processing" means that beans are
- 11 loaded by the grower, in bulk or loose in bags or other containers,
- 12 or packed in any style package, in a car, boat, truck, wagon, or
- 13 other conveyance to be transported to a processor.
- Sec. 2. For the purposes of this act, the state is divided
- 15 into 8-7 districts:
- 16 (a) District 1 consists of the counties of Arenac, Bay, and
- 17 Midland plus all counties north of Midland county COUNTY that are
- 18 not otherwise designated in a district.
- 19 (b) District 2 consists of the county COUNTIES of Gratiot AND
- 20 SAGINAW.
- (c) District 3 consists of the county of Tuscola.
- 22 (d) District 4 consists of the counties of Genesee, Lapeer,
- 23 Macomb, St. Clair, and Sanilac.
- 24 (e) District 5 consists of the eastern half of the county of
- 25 Huron using highway 53 as the western boundary.
- (f) District 6 consists of the western half of the county of
- 27 Huron using highway 53 as the eastern boundary.

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- 1 (g) District 7 consists of the counties of Montcalm, Kent,
- 2 Isabella, Mecosta, Eaton, Ingham, Clinton, and Shiawassee plus all
- 3 counties west and south of this district not otherwise designated
- 4 in a district.
- 5 (h) District 8 consists of the county of Saginaw.
- 6 Sec. 3. (1) The Michigan bean commission of 9 voting members
- 7 is created, consisting of a grower from each district created under
- 8 section 2, 1 MEMBER AT LARGE, and 1 processor shipper handler
- 9 member under section 4(2). The director and the dean of the college
- 10 of agriculture AND NATURAL RESOURCES of Michigan state university,
- 11 STATE UNIVERSITY, or their designees, are ex officio members
- 12 without vote. An appointed member shall MUST be of legal voting age
- 13 in this state, and shall MUST be a citizen and resident of this
- 14 state. Commission members, except for the processor member, shall
- 15 MUST be or shall MUST have been engaged in the actual growing or
- 16 producing of beans within the state.
- 17 (2) The terms of office of members of the commission shall be
- 18 ARE 3 years after the date of appointment or until their successors
- 19 are appointed and qualified.
- 20 (3) Not less than 5 years after June 29, 1989 and every 5
- 21 calendar years after that date, the commission may, with the advice
- 22 and consent of the director and the commission of agriculture AND
- 23 RURAL DEVELOPMENT, reapportion the districts described in section
- 24 2. Reapportionment of the districts shall MUST be on the basis of 1
- 25 or more counties with the amount of planted dry bean acreage being
- 26 as nearly equal as possible between districts except that if 1
- 27 county constitutes greater than 20% of the total bean production

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- 1 within the state, then that county may be divided into 2 or more
- 2 relatively equal districts.
- 3 (4) After the reapportionment described in subsection (3), if
- 4 the residence of a member of the commission falls outside of the
- 5 district for which he or she serves on the commission and falls
- 6 within the district for which another member serves on the
- 7 commission, then both members shall continue to serve on the
- 8 commission for a term equal to the remaining term of the member who
- 9 served for the longest period of time. If after the reapportionment
- 10 described in subsection (3) a district is created in which no
- 11 member serving on the commission resides, then a member shall MUST
- 12 be selected in a manner described in section 4(2).
- Sec. 4. (1) The governor shall appoint the first members of
- 14 the commission within 30 days after this act takes effect BEFORE
- 15 JANUARY 31, 1966 with the advice and consent of the senate and
- 16 without use of the nominating procedures provided in this section.
- 17 The EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (4), THE governor shall
- 18 appoint subsequent members only from the lists of nominees
- 19 submitted to him or her and subject to the advice and consent of
- 20 the senate. If a list is not submitted to the governor at least 30
- 21 days before the term of office of a member would normally expire,
- 22 or within 30 days after a vacancy otherwise occurs, the governor
- 23 may appoint any person-INDIVIDUAL who is otherwise qualified under
- 24 this act.
- 25 (2) A-EXCEPT FOR A VACANCY FOR A MEMBER AT LARGE AS PROVIDED
- 26 IN SUBSECTION (4), A meeting of growers shall MUST be held in each
- 27 district in each year when a vacancy occurs. The commission shall

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- 1 give notice of each meeting by at least 2 insertions in a farm
- 2 publication of general circulation in the district where the
- 3 meeting is to be held, with the final insertion to be at least 10
- 4 days before the meeting. The commission shall supervise the conduct
- 5 of the meeting. Two nominees for members of the commission shall
- 6 MUST be selected at each meeting and submitted to the governor.
- 7 Appointment of a processor shipper handler member shall MUST be
- 8 made only from any list submitted to the governor by the commission
- 9 with 2 names submitted for the appointment of that member.
- 10 (3) A member of the commission who fails to meet the
- 11 qualifications of this act shall cease to be a member of the
- 12 commission. This EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (4), THIS vacancy
- 13 or a vacancy for another reason shall MUST be filled by the
- 14 governor for the unexpired term in the same manner as the original
- **15** appointment.
- 16 (4) BEGINNING WITH THE COMMISSION'S FIRST ANNUAL MEETING
- 17 FOLLOWING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS
- 18 SUBSECTION AND FOR EVERY MEMBER AT-LARGE VACANCY THAT FOLLOWS, THE
- 19 SELECTION MEMBERS SHALL SELECT AND APPOINT THE MEMBER AT LARGE AT
- 20 THE COMMISSION'S ANNUAL MEETING.
- 21 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 22 after the date it is enacted into law.
