## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 6086

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"

(MCL 436.1101 to 436.2303) by adding section 905a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 905A. (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2), A PERSON
- 2 LICENSED UNDER THIS ACT TO SELL ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR FOR CONSUMPTION ON
- 3 OR OFF THE LICENSED PREMISES AT RETAIL SHALL POST IN A CONSPICUOUS
- 4 LOCATION A SIGN INFORMING THE PUBLIC OF THE EFFECTS OF ALCOHOL
- 5 CONSUMPTION DURING PREGNANCY. THE SIGN SHALL CONTAIN THE MESSAGE:
- 6 "PREGNANCY AND ALCOHOL DO NOT MIX. DRINKING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OF
- 7 ANY TYPE DURING PREGNANCY CAN CAUSE BIRTH DEFECTS.". THE COMMISSION
- 8 SHALL DEVELOP AND FURNISH THE SIGN.
- 9 (2) IF THE PERSON DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) SELLS ALCOHOLIC
- 10 LIQUOR FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE LICENSED PREMISES, INSTEAD OF POSTING

- 1 A SIGN THE PERSON MAY PLACE THE MESSAGE REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (1)
- 2 ON A MENU.
- Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 180 days 3
- 4 after the date it is enacted into law.
