## **HOUSE BILL No. 6398**

September 26, 2018, Introduced by Rep. Allor and referred to the Committee on Michigan Competitiveness.

A bill to amend 1980 PA 469, entitled "The whistleblowers' protection act," by amending sections 2 and 7 (MCL 15.362 and 15.367).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 2. (1) An employer shall not discharge, threaten, or

otherwise discriminate against an employee regarding the employee's compensation, terms, conditions, location, or privileges of employment because the employee, or a person acting on behalf of the employee, reports or is about to report, verbally or in writing, a violation or a suspected violation of a law or regulation or rule promulgated pursuant to law of this state, a political subdivision of this state, or the United States to a public body, unless the employee knows that the report is false, or

- 13 BECAUSE AN EMPLOYEE IS REQUESTED BY THE UNITED STATES COAST GUARD
- 14 OR OTHER APPROPRIATE FEDERAL AGENCY OR DEPARTMENT TO PARTICIPATE IN
- 15 AN INVESTIGATION, HEARING, OR INQUIRY HELD BY THE UNITED STATES
- 16 COAST GUARD OR OTHER APPROPRIATE FEDERAL AGENCY OR DEPARTMENT, OR A
- 17 COURT ACTION.
- 18 Sec. 7. This act shall DOES not be construed to require an
- 19 employer to compensate an employee for participation in an
- 20 investigation, hearing, or inquiry held by a public body in
- 21 accordance with UNDER section 2. of this act.
- 22 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 23 after the date it is enacted into law.
