SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5851

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled

"The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1308a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1308A. (1) A SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL
- 2 DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL PROVIDE A REPORT TO THE
- 3 DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE, IN A FORM AND MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THE
- 4 DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE, ON BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING TYPES OF
- 5 INCIDENTS REGARDING A SCHOOL OPERATED BY THE SCHOOL DISTRICT,
- 6 INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY WITHIN 24
- 7 HOURS AFTER THE INCIDENT OCCURS:
- 8 (A) AN INCIDENT INVOLVING A CRIME THAT WOULD BE REQUIRED TO BE
- 9 REPORTED UNDER SECTION 1310A(2).
- 10 (B) AN INCIDENT, IF KNOWN TO THE SCHOOL, INVOLVING THE

- 1 ATTEMPTED COMMISSION OF A CRIME THAT WOULD BE REQUIRED TO BE
- 2 REPORTED UNDER SECTION 1310A(2).
- 3 (2) AT LEAST QUARTERLY, THE OFFICE OF SCHOOL SAFETY CREATED BY
- 4 LAW SHALL COMPILE A REPORT ON THE INFORMATION RECEIVED UNDER
- 5 SUBSECTION (1) AND MAKE THE REPORT AVAILABLE TO THE SCHOOL SAFETY
- 6 COMMISSION CREATED UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE COMPREHENSIVE SCHOOL
- 7 SAFETY PLAN ACT, THE DEPARTMENT, AND ANY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY
- 8 UPON REQUEST.
- 9 (3) A REPORT UNDER THIS SECTION IS EXEMPT FROM THE FREEDOM OF
- 10 INFORMATION ACT, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.231 TO 15.246.
- 11 (4) IF A SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR
- 12 PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY FAILS TO COMPLY WITH SUBSECTION (1), THE
- 13 DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE MAY DETERMINE THAT THE SCHOOL DISTRICT,
- 14 INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY IS
- 15 INELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE ANY SCHOOL SAFETY GRANTS FROM THE DEPARTMENT
- 16 OF STATE POLICE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR IN WHICH THE NONCOMPLIANCE IS
- 17 DISCOVERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE.
- 18 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 19 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 20 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 21 unless all of the following bills of the 99th Legislature are
