## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 CHAPTER VII--POWERS OF COUNCIL
- 2 Sec. 2. (1) The EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS
- 3 SUBSECTION, THE council may prescribe the terms and conditions upon
- 4 which a license shall be IS granted and may require payment of a
- 5 reasonable and proper sum AMOUNT for a license. The person
- 6 receiving the license shall, if required by the council or an
- 7 ordinance of the village, before the issuing of the license,
- 8 execute a bond to the village in a sum AN AMOUNT prescribed by the
- 9 council, with 1 or more sufficient sureties, conditioned for a
- 10 faithful performance of the laws relating to the village and the

- 1 ordinances of the council, and otherwise conditioned as the council
- 2 may prescribe. A license is revocable by the council. If a license
- 3 is revoked for noncompliance with the terms and conditions upon
- 4 which it THE LICENSE was granted, or on account of a violation of
- 5 an ordinance or regulation passed or authorized by the council, the
- 6 person holding the license shall, in addition to any other
- 7 sanctions imposed, forfeit payments made for the license. The
- 8 council may provide sanctions for a person who, without license,
- 9 does something for which a license is required by an ordinance of
- 10 the council. THIS SUBSECTION IS SUBJECT TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT
- 11 OCCUPATIONAL LICENSING ACT.
- 12 (2) The council of a village may provide for the support and
- 13 relief of poor persons residing in the village and, for that
- 14 purpose, may provide, by ordinance or resolution, for the
- 15 appointment of a director of the poor for the village and may
- 16 prescribe the director's duties and vest him or her with authority
- 17 proper for the exercise of those duties.
- 18 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act is retroactive and
- 19 takes effect January 1, 2018.
- 20 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 21 unless House Bill No. 5955 of the 99th Legislature is enacted into
- 22 law.
