## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5989

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 80213 (MCL 324.80213), as added by 2000 PA 229.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 80213. (1) An individual who is required to complete a
- 2 boating safety course under this part and who operates a personal
- 3 watercraft on the waters of this state shall display his or her
- 4 boating safety certificate OR, AT THE INDIVIDUAL'S OPTION, AN
- 5 ELECTRONIC COPY, IN A FORMAT APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT, OF THE
- 6 BOATING SAFETY CERTIFICATE upon the demand of a peace officer who
- 7 identifies himself or herself as a peace officer. NOT LATER THAN
- 8 MARCH 31, 2019, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL APPROVE 1 OR MORE FORMATS FOR
- 9 AN INDIVIDUAL TO DISPLAY AN ELECTRONIC COPY OF HIS OR HER BOATING

- 1 SAFETY CERTIFICATE.
- 2 (2) A person shall display only his or her own boating safety
- 3 certificate upon the demand of a peace officer under subsection

- 5 (3) A person shall not display a fraudulent boating safety
- 6 certificate to a peace officer under subsection (1).
- 7 (2) (4) A peace officer shall not stop a personal watercraft
- 8 solely for the purpose of determining whether the operator has in
- 9 his or her possession a—EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 10 (A) A boating safety certificate.
- 11 (B) AN ELECTRONIC COPY OF A BOATING SAFETY CERTIFICATE IN A
- 12 FORMAT APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- 13 (3) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO, UNDER SUBSECTION (1), DISPLAYS AN
- 14 ELECTRONIC COPY OF HIS OR HER BOATING SAFETY CERTIFICATE USING AN
- 15 ELECTRONIC DEVICE IS NOT PRESUMED TO HAVE CONSENTED TO A SEARCH OF
- 16 THE ELECTRONIC DEVICE. THIS STATE, AN EMPLOYEE OF THIS STATE, A
- 17 PEACE OFFICER, OR AN ENTITY EMPLOYING THE PEACE OFFICER IS NOT
- 18 LIABLE FOR DAMAGE TO OR LOSS OF AN ELECTRONIC DEVICE THAT OCCURS AS
- 19 A RESULT OF THE PEACE OFFICER'S VIEWING AN ELECTRONIC COPY OF A
- 20 BOATING SAFETY CERTIFICATE UNDER SUBSECTION (1), REGARDLESS OF
- 21 WHETHER THE PEACE OFFICER WAS IN POSSESSION OF THE ELECTRONIC
- 22 DEVICE AT THE TIME THE DAMAGE OR LOSS OCCURRED.
- 23 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 24 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 25 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 26 unless all of the following bills of the 99th Legislature are
- 27 enacted into law:
