A bill to amend 2001 PA 142, entitled "Michigan memorial highway act,"

(MCL 250.1001 to 250.2080) by adding section 11a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 11A. THE PORTION OF HIGHWAY US-23 IN GENESEE COUNTY
- 2 BEGINNING AT THE INTERSECTION OF HIGHWAY US-23 AND THOMPSON ROAD
- 3 AND EXTENDING NORTH TO THE INTERSECTION OF HIGHWAY US-23 AND
- 4 BRISTOL ROAD SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE "SERGEANT JOE JOHNSON MEMORIAL
- 5 HIGHWAY".
- 6 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 7 after the date it is enacted into law.
