## HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 727

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

by amending section 1531i (MCL 380.1531i), as added by 2009 PA 202.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1531i. (1) The superintendent of public instruction shall
- 2 establish a process for a person AN INDIVIDUAL to earn an interim
- 3 teaching certificate under this section that qualifies the person
- 4 INDIVIDUAL to teach in the public schools and to earn a Michigan
- 5 teaching certificate using the process under this section. The
- 6 process shall meet all applicable requirements for an alternative
- 7 teaching certification process under the no child left behind act
- 8 of 2001, Public Law 107-110. The process shall not allow for an
- 9 interim teaching certificate for special education.
- 10 (2) The process established under subsection (1) shall provide

- 1 that the superintendent of public instruction will grant an interim
- 2 teaching certificate to a person AN INDIVIDUAL who meets all of the
- 3 following:
- 4 (a) Is a participant in an alternative teaching program that
- 5 is approved by the superintendent of public instruction. To be
- 6 approved, a program provider shall demonstrate to the satisfaction
- 7 of the superintendent of public instruction that it meets all of
- 8 the following:
- 9 (i) Provides for its participants an intensive training
- 10 program in teaching that is determined by the superintendent of
- 11 public instruction to constitute the equivalent of at least 12
- 12 college credit hours and that includes training in at least all of
- 13 the following subject areas:
- 14 (A) Child development or child psychology.
- 15 (B) Family and community relationships.
- 16 (C) Diverse learners.
- 17 (D) Instructional strategies.
- (E) A form of field-based experience in a classroom setting.
- 19 (ii) Has a proven record of producing successful teachers  $\frac{1}{2}$  1
- 20 or more other states or is modeled after a program that has a
- 21 proven record of producing successful teachers. in 1 or more other
- 22 states.
- 23 (iii) ITS PARTICIPANTS HAVE A COHORT GRADE POINT AVERAGE OF AT
- 24 LEAST 3.0 ON A 4.0 SCALE OR THE EQUIVALENT ON ANOTHER SCALE, AS
- 25 DETERMINED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION, UPON
- 26 EARNING THE DEGREE REQUIRED UNDER SUBDIVISION (B). IF A COHORT
- 27 MEMBER HAS EARNED MORE THAN 1 DEGREE REQUIRED UNDER SUBDIVISION

- 1 (B), THE HIGHEST GRADE POINT AVERAGE EARNED BY THE COHORT MEMBER
- 2 MUST BE USED IN CALCULATING THE COHORT GRADE POINT AVERAGE UNDER
- 3 THIS SUBPARAGRAPH.
- 4 (iv) (iii)—Accepts for participation only persons—INDIVIDUALS
- 5 who meet the requirements of subdivision (b).
- 6 (b) Holds a bachelor's, master's, doctorate, or professional
- 7 degree from a regionally accredited college or university. with a
- 8 grade point average of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or the
- 9 equivalent on another scale, as determined by the superintendent of
- 10 public instruction.
- 11 (c) Passes both the basic skills examination and the
- 12 appropriate available subject area examination for each subject
- 13 area in which he or she applies to be certified.
- 14 (3) A person AN INDIVIDUAL earning a provisional MICHIGAN
- 15 TEACHING certificate USING THE PROCESS under this section will be
- 16 subject to provisions of administrative rules governing teachers,
- 17 as established by the superintendent of public instruction.
- 18 (4) A person—AN INDIVIDUAL who possesses an interim teaching
- 19 certificate under this section may be employed to teach in a public
- 20 school in the same manner as a person AN INDIVIDUAL holding a
- 21 Michigan teaching certificate issued under section 1531 if all of
- 22 the following requirements are met:
- 23 (a) While the person-INDIVIDUAL is teaching under an interim
- 24 teaching certificate, the school district or public school academy
- 25 in which the person-INDIVIDUAL is teaching provides intensive
- 26 observation and coaching in a manner and to the extent prescribed
- 27 by the superintendent of public instruction.

- 1 (b) The person INDIVIDUAL is making satisfactory progress
- 2 toward meeting the requirements for being awarded a Michigan
- 3 teaching certificate under section 1531, as established by the
- 4 superintendent of public instruction under subsection (5).
- 5 (5) The superintendent of public instruction shall develop
- 6 standards for granting a person AN INDIVIDUAL a Michigan teaching
- 7 certificate issued under section 1531 after the person-INDIVIDUAL
- 8 has demonstrated satisfactory teaching performance for 3 years
- 9 under an interim teaching certificate and has met the requirements
- 10 established by the superintendent of public instruction for a
- 11 Michigan teaching certificate.
- 12 (6) The superintendent of public instruction shall promulgate
- 13 rules that he or she considers necessary to implement this section.
- 14 (7) As used in this section: , "basic skills examination",
- 15 "elementary
- 16 (A) "COHORT" MEANS ALL OF THE INDIVIDUALS ENROLLED IN AN
- 17 ALTERNATIVE TEACHING PROGRAM APPROVED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF
- 18 PUBLIC INSTRUCTION FOR THE 3 YEARS IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE
- 19 GRANTING OF AN INTERIM TEACHING CERTIFICATE UNDER THIS SECTION TO
- 20 AN INDIVIDUAL ENROLLED IN THE ALTERNATIVE TEACHING PROGRAM.
- 21 (B) "ELEMENTARY certification examination" and "subject area
- 22 examination" mean those terms as defined in section 1531.
