

SENATE BILL No. 18

January 18, 2017, Introduced by Senators HORN, O'BRIEN, PROOS, JONES, COLBECK, KNOLLENBERG, BOOHER, SCHUITMAKER, BRANDENBURG, HANSEN, KOWALL, GREGORY and JOHNSON and referred to the Committee on Michigan Competitiveness.

A bill to amend 1953 PA 232, entitled
"Corrections code of 1953,"
(MCL 791.201 to 791.285) by adding section 84.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 84. (1) ON A QUARTERLY BASIS, EACH FIELD OPERATIONS
2 ADMINISTRATION REGION SHALL PROVIDE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND
3 HUMAN SERVICES A LIST OF SUPERVISED INDIVIDUALS WITHIN THAT REGION
4 WHO HAVE ABSCONDED FROM SUPERVISION AND WHOM A LAW ENFORCEMENT
5 AGENCY IS ACTIVELY SEEKING.

6 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:

7 (A) "ABSCOND" MEANS THE INTENTIONAL FAILURE OF AN INDIVIDUAL
8 SUPERVISED UNDER THIS ACT TO REPORT TO HIS OR HER SUPERVISING AGENT
9 AND TO ADVISE HIS OR HER SUPERVISING AGENT OF HIS OR HER
10 WHEREABOUTS.

1 (B) "ACTIVELY SEEKING" MEANS EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:

2 (i) A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY INTENDS TO ENFORCE AN OUTSTANDING
3 FELONY WARRANT FOR A SUPERVISED INDIVIDUAL OR ARREST A SUPERVISED
4 INDIVIDUAL FOR A PAROLE VIOLATION OR FOR ABSCONDING FROM
5 SUPERVISION WITHIN THE FOLLOWING 30 DAYS.

6 (ii) THE SUPERVISED INDIVIDUAL HAS AN ACTIVE WARRANT FOR 1 OF
7 THE FOLLOWING NATIONAL CRIME INFORMATION CENTER CATEGORIES:

8 (A) ESCAPE.

9 (B) FLIGHT TO AVOID.

10 (C) FLIGHT AND ESCAPE.

11 (C) "FIELD OPERATIONS ADMINISTRATION REGION" MEANS 1 OF THE
12 GEOGRAPHIC REGIONS DELINEATED BY THE DEPARTMENT THAT ARE CHARGED
13 WITH THE RESPONSIBILITY OF OVERSEEING SUPERVISED INDIVIDUALS WITHIN
14 THE REGION, INCLUDING INDIVIDUALS ON PROBATION AND INDIVIDUALS
15 RELEASED FROM PRISON ON PAROLE, AND THAT EMPLOY PAROLE AND
16 PROBATION AGENTS TO ENGAGE IN DIRECT SUPERVISION OF THE SUPERVISED
17 INDIVIDUALS.

18 (D) "SUPERVISED INDIVIDUAL" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS BEEN
19 RELEASED FROM PRISON ON PAROLE.

20 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
21 after the date it is enacted into law.

22 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
23 unless Senate Bill No. 19.
