SUBSTITUTE FOR

SENATE BILL NO. 368

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 136a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 136A. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT KNOWINGLY TRANSPORT ANOTHER
- 2 PERSON FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONDUCT WITH REGARD TO THAT OTHER PERSON
- 3 THAT WOULD BE A VIOLATION OF SECTION 136 IF THE CONDUCT OCCURRED IN
- 4 THIS STATE.
- 5 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY
- 6 PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 15 YEARS.
- 7 (3) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT A PERSON FROM BEING CHARGED
- 8 WITH, CONVICTED OF, OR PUNISHED FOR ANY OTHER VIOLATION OF LAW
- 9 ARISING OUT OF THE SAME TRANSACTION AS THE VIOLATION OF THIS
- 10 SECTION.

- 1 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 2 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 3 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 4 unless Senate Bill No. 337 of the 99th Legislature is enacted into
- 5 law.
