- 3 APPLICANT TO SUBMIT A VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATION ELECTRONICALLY
- 4 THROUGH THE SECRETARY OF STATE'S WEBSITE. THE ELECTRONIC VOTER
  - REGISTRATION INTERFACE MUST DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
    - (A) TRANSMIT THE APPLICATION TO THE QUALIFIED VOTER FILE.
    - (B) INTERACT WITH THE STATE OPERATOR'S OR CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE
- 8 FILE AND THE OFFICIAL STATE PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION CARD FILE FOR
- 9 AUTHENTICATION PURPOSES.
