A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

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SENATE BILL No. 634

by amending section 18223 (MCL 333.18223), as amended by 2014 PA $_{385}$.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 18223. (1) The department, in consultation with the
- 2 board, shall promulgate rules requiring that to be granted a
- 3 license under this part, except as provided in subsection (2), an
- 4 individual must meet both ALL of the following requirements:
 - (a) Have been granted a doctoral degree in psychology, or a doctoral degree in a closely related field, from a doctoral degree program that meets both of the following requirements:
 - (i) Is offered by a regionally accredited or other college, university, or institution approved by the board, which program included AND INCLUDES education and training appropriate to the

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- 1 practice of psychology.
- 2 (ii) Has obtained the association ASSOCIATION of state STATE
- 3 and provincial psychology boards' PROVINCIAL PSYCHOLOGY BOARDS'
- 4 national register designation, has been accredited by the American
- 5 psychological association PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSOCIATION or the Canadian
- 6 psychological association, PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSOCIATION, or has
- 7 obtained a similar designation from or been accredited by an entity
- 8 approved by the board. For purposes of the requirement added by
- 9 2010 PA 121, HOWEVER, a program that is in the process of obtaining
- 10 the designation or becoming accredited as required in this sub-
- 11 subparagraph SUBPARAGRAPH before August 1, 2011, and that obtains
- 12 the designation or becomes accredited on or before August 31, 2020,
- 13 meets the requirements of this sub-subparagraph.SUBPARAGRAPH.
- 14 (b) Have not less than 1 year of postdoctoral experience in
- 15 the practice of psychology in an organized health care setting or
- 16 other arrangement, as established by the board.
- 17 (2) In addition to section 16182, the board shall grant a
- 18 limited license to an individual granted a master's degree in
- 19 psychology from a regionally accredited college, or university, or
- 20 institution approved by the board, if the individual has education,
- 21 training, and experience appropriate to the practice of psychology,
- 22 as established by the board. Except for duties performed as an
- 23 employee of a governmental entity or of a nonprofit organization
- 24 serving benevolent and charitable purposes, the board shall place 2
- 25 limitations on a license granted to an individual under this
- 26 subsection. The limitations must require supervision by a
- 27 psychologist who has a license other than a limited license and

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- 1 must prohibit advertising or other representation to the public
- 2 that will lead the public to believe the individual is engaging in
- 3 the practice of psychology. A limited license granted under this
- 4 subsection is renewable pursuant to UNDER part 161. An individual
- 5 applying for a limited license pursuant to **UNDER** this subsection
- 6 must have 1 year of supervised postgraduate experience in an
- 7 organized health care setting or other arrangement, as established
- 8 by the board. The individual must be supervised by a psychologist
- 9 who has a license other than a limited license, or if a
- 10 psychologist who has a license other than a limited license is not
- 11 available, by a psychologist who has at least a master's degree in
- 12 psychology and at least 3 years of experience in the practice of
- 13 psychology or by any other individual approved by the board. The
- 14 (3) THE board shall issue GRANT a temporary license to the AN
- 15 individual **DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (2)** for the purpose of obtaining
- 16 the 1 year of postgraduate experience DESCRIBED IN THAT SUBSECTION.

- 20 (2) WAS GRANTED A TEMPORARY LICENSE BY THE BOARD BEFORE DECEMBER
- 21 31, 2017, HIS OR HER TEMPORARY LICENSE MAY BE RENEWED FOR 1
- 22 ADDITIONAL 24-MONTH TERM.
- 23 (4) THE BOARD SHALL GRANT A TEMPORARY LICENSE TO AN INDIVIDUAL
- 24 WHO IS ENROLLED IN A DOCTORAL DEGREE PROGRAM THAT MEETS THE
- 25 REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (1). BEGINNING ON DECEMBER 31, 2017, A
- 26 TEMPORARY LICENSE GRANTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION IS VALID FOR 24
- 27 MONTHS AND MAY BE RENEWED FOR 3 ADDITIONAL 24-MONTH TERMS. IF AN

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- 1 INDIVIDUAL ENROLLED IN A DOCTORAL PROGRAM THAT MEETS THE
- 2 REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (1) WAS GRANTED A TEMPORARY LICENSE BY
- 3 THE BOARD BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2017, HIS OR HER TEMPORARY LICENSE
- 4 MAY BE RENEWED FOR 3 ADDITIONAL 24-MONTH TERMS.
