SUBSTITUTE FOR

SENATE BILL NO. 881

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 3116 (MCL 324.3116).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3116. (1) This part does not repeal any law governing the
- 2 pollution of lakes and streams, but shall be held and construed as
- 3 ancillary to and supplementing the other laws and in addition to
- 4 the laws now in force, except as a law may be in direct conflict
- 5 with this part. This part does not apply to copper or iron FERROUS
- 6 AND NONFERROUS mining operations , whereby such operations result
- 7 in Subject to parts 631 and 632 with respect to mining areas, as
- 8 DEFINED IN SECTIONS 63101 AND 63201, WITH REGARD TO the placement,
- 9 removal, use, or processing of copper or iron mineral tailings or
- 10 copper or iron mineral deposits from such operations being placed

- 1 in inland waters on bottomlands owned by or under the control of
- 2 the mining company and only water which may contain a minimal
- amount of residue as determined by the department resulting from 3
- 4 such placement, removal, use, or processing being allowed or
- permitted to escape into public waters. FERROUS OR NONFERROUS 5
- MINERAL OPERATOR UNLESS THERE IS TO BE A DISCHARGE OF WASTE OR
- WASTE EFFLUENT FROM THE INLAND WATERS INTO WATERS OF THE STATE. 7
- This part does not apply to the discharge of water from underground 8
- iron or copper FERROUS AND NONFERROUS mining operations subject to 9
- a determination by the department. UNLESS THERE IS TO BE A DISCHARGE 10
- 11 OF WASTE OR WASTE EFFLUENT INTO THE WATERS OF THE STATE.
- 12 (2) THE EXEMPTION PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (1) DOES NOT APPLY TO
- INLAND WATERS OWNED BY OR UNDER CONTROL OF A FERROUS OR NONFERROUS 13
- MINERAL OPERATOR IF THERE IS AN INLAND LAKE OR STREAM AS DEFINED IN 14
- SECTION 30101 THAT FLOWS BOTH INTO THOSE INLAND WATERS AND OUT FROM 15
- THOSE INLAND WATERS DIRECTLY INTO THE WATERS OF THE STATE. 16
- 17 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- after the date it is enacted into law. 18
