SENATE BILL No. 1195

November 8, 2018, Introduced by Senator WARREN and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," (MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding section 11109.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 11109. (1) THE OWNER OR OPERATOR OF A LANDFILL SHALL PAY
- 2 TO THE DEPARTMENT A FEE ASSESSED ON TENORM DISPOSED OF IN THE
- 3 LANDFILL. THE FEE IS \$5.00 PER TON, BASED ON THE QUANTITY OF TENORM
- 4 SPECIFIED ON THE MONTHLY OPERATING REPORT. THE FEE FOR FRACTIONAL
- 5 TONS OF TENORM SHALL BE PROPORTIONAL. THE FEE SHALL BE PAID WITHIN
- 6 30 DAYS AFTER THE END OF EACH CALENDAR YEAR QUARTER.
- 7 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL TAKE ENFORCEMENT ACTION TO COLLECT
- 8 FEES THAT ARE NOT PAID AS REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION.
- 9 (3) THE LANDFILL OWNER OR OPERATOR SHALL FORWARD TO THE
- 10 DEPARTMENT THE FEE REVENUE DUE UNDER THIS SECTION WITH A COMPLETED
- 11 FORM THAT IS PROVIDED OR APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT. THE OWNER OR

- 1 OPERATOR SHALL CERTIFY THAT ALL INFORMATION PROVIDED IN THE FORM IS
- 2 ACCURATE. THE FORM SHALL SPECIFY THE VOLUME OF TENORM DISPOSED OF
- 3 AT THE LANDFILL DURING THE PRECEDING CALENDAR QUARTER AND THE
- 4 AMOUNT OF FEE REVENUE BEING FORWARDED TO THE DEPARTMENT.
- 5 (4) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAINTAIN INFORMATION REGARDING THE
- 6 FEES COLLECTED UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 7 (5) THE TENORM ACCOUNT IS CREATED WITHIN THE ENVIRONMENTAL
- 8 POLLUTION PREVENTION FUND CREATED IN SECTION 11130. THE DEPARTMENT
- 9 SHALL FORWARD FEES COLLECTED UNDER THIS SECTION TO THE STATE
- 10 TREASURER FOR DEPOSIT IN THE TENORM ACCOUNT. THE STATE TREASURER
- 11 MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT
- 12 INTO THE ACCOUNT. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT
- 13 OF THE ACCOUNT. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT TO THE ACCOUNT
- 14 INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM ACCOUNT INVESTMENTS. MONEY REMAINING IN
- 15 THE ACCOUNT AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL NOT LAPSE TO THE
- 16 GENERAL FUND.
- 17 (6) MONEY FROM THE TENORM ACCOUNT SHALL BE EXPENDED, UPON
- 18 APPROPRIATION, ONLY FOR 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING PURPOSES:
- 19 (A) TO PAY REFUNDS TO GENERATORS UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 20 (B) TO FUND THE DEPARTMENT'S REGULATION AND OVERSIGHT OF THE
- 21 DISPOSAL OF TENORM IN THIS STATE.
- 22 (C) TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO LOCAL UNITS OF GOVERNMENT AND
- 23 LANDFILL OPERATORS TO OBTAIN EQUIPMENT TO MONITOR TENORM RADIATION.
- 24 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 25 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 26 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 27 unless Senate Bill No. 1196
