SENATE BILL No. 1248

November 29, 2018, Introduced by Senator ROBERTSON and referred to the Committee on Elections and Government Reform.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 472, entitled

"An act to regulate political activity; to regulate lobbyists, lobbyist agents, and lobbying activities; to require registration of lobbyists and lobbyist agents; to require the filing of reports; to prescribe the powers and duties of the department of state; to prescribe penalties; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

by amending sections 2 and 4 (MCL 4.412 and 4.414), section 4 as amended by 2008 PA 289.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2. (1) "Administrative action" means the proposal,
- 2 drafting, development, consideration, amendment, enactment, or
- 3 defeat of a nonministerial action or rule by an executive agency or
- an official in the executive branch of state government.
- 5 Administrative action does not include a quasi-judicial

- 2 (2) "Business" means a corporation, partnership, sole
- 3 proprietorship, firm, enterprise, franchise, association,

- 1 (d) A breakfast, luncheon, dinner, or other refreshment
- 2 consisting of food and beverage provided for immediate consumption.
- 3 (e) A contribution to a legal defense fund that is registered
- 4 with the secretary of state COMMISSION under the legal defense fund
- 5 act, 2008 PA 288, MCL 15.521 TO 15.539, and whose purpose is to
- 6 defend an elected official against any criminal, civil, or
- 7 administrative action, that arises directly out of the conduct of
- 8 the elected official's governmental duties.
- 9 (2) "Immediate family" means a—ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 10 (A) A child residing in an individual's household. 7 a

- 12 (C) AN individual claimed by that individual or that
- 13 individual's spouse as a dependent for federal income tax purposes.
- 14 (3) "Loan" means a transfer of money, property, or anything of
- 15 ascertainable value in exchange for an obligation, conditional or
- 16 not, to repay in whole or in part.
