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## **HOUSE BILL No. 4181**

February 8, 2017, Introduced by Reps. Roberts, Wentworth and Frederick and referred to the Committee on Workforce and Talent Development.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

by amending section 1233 (MCL 380.1233), as amended by 2016 PA 192.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1233. (1) Except as otherwise provided by law, and subject to section 1233c, the board of a school district or intermediate school board of an intermediate school district shall not permit a teacher who does not hold a valid teaching certificate to teach in a grade or department of the school.
  - (2) The board of a school district or intermediate school board of an intermediate school district shall not allow an individual to serve in a counseling role in the school district or intermediate school district, as the role is defined by the superintendent of public instruction, unless the individual meets 1 or more of the following: and the board or intermediate school

- 1 board complies with subsection (7):
- 2 (a) The individual holds a valid teaching certificate with a
- 3 school counseling endorsement.
- 4 (b) The individual meets all of the following:
- 5 (i) Holds a master's degree awarded after completion of an
- 6 approved school counselor education program that includes at least
- 7 all of the following skills and content areas or their equivalent:
- 8 (A) Guidance services--philosophy, principles, and practices.
- **9** (B) Individual and group analysis--nature and range of human
- 10 characteristics and appraisal methods.
- 11 (C) Guidance information--vocational development theory,
- 12 educational and occupational information.
- 13 (D) Counseling theory and practice--individual and group
- 14 procedures, administration and coordination relationships,
- 15 professional relationships, and ethics.
- 16 (E) Supervised experiences--laboratory, practicum, or
- 17 internship.
- 18 (F) Evaluation--statistics and research methodology, follow-up
- 19 evaluation, and measurement methods.
- 20 (ii) Has successfully completed the department's guidance
- 21 counselor examination.
- 22 (iii) Has been recommended by an approved school counselor
- 23 education program to provide services as a school counselor.
- 24 (c) The individual meets both of the following:
- 25 (i) Has at least 5 years of successful experience serving in a
- 26 school counseling role in another state within the immediately
- 27 preceding 7-year period.

- (ii) Has successfully completed the department's guidance
  counselor examination.
- **3** (3) Except for teachers engaged to teach in a community
- 4 district under section 1233c, the intermediate superintendent shall
- 5 notify the superintendent of public instruction immediately of the
- 6 names of noncertificated teachers teaching in violation of
- 7 subsection (1) and the names of individuals serving in counseling
- 8 roles in violation of subsection (2), the employing district, and
- 9 the amount of time the noncertificated teachers or unqualified
- 10 individuals were employed.
- 11 (4) A vocational teacher preparation institution shall utilize
- 12 the employment experience of an annually authorized teacher for the
- 13 purpose of waiving student teaching as a requirement for vocational
- 14 certification if the annually authorized teacher is supervised by
- 15 the teacher preparation institution.
- 16 (5) All vocational education teachers certified after June 1,
- 17 1995 shall pass a competency test.
- 18 (6) The board of a school district or intermediate school
- 19 district may employ an individual without a teaching certificate as
- 20 a substitute teacher if the individual has at least 90 semester
- 21 hours of college credit from a college or university.
- 22 (7) If the board of a school district or intermediate school
- 23 board of an intermediate school district chooses to employ an
- 24 individual who does not hold a valid teaching certificate to serve
- 25 in a counseling role, as permitted under subsection (2), the school
- 26 board or intermediate school board shall comply with sections 1230
- 27 and 1230a with respect to that individual to the same extent as

- 1 required for employing an individual with a teaching certificate to
- 2 serve as a teacher.
- 3 (7) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2019, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT RENEW
- 4 AN INDIVIDUAL'S SCHOOL COUNSELOR CREDENTIAL UNLESS THE DEPARTMENT
- 5 DETERMINES THAT THE INDIVIDUAL HAS, WITHIN THE TIME PERIOD SINCE
- 6 THE INDIVIDUAL'S SCHOOL COUNSELOR CREDENTIAL WAS ISSUED OR LAST
- 7 RENEWED, WHICHEVER IS MOST RECENT, COMPLETED AS PART OF AND NOT IN
- 8 ADDITION TO REQUIREMENTS PRESCRIBED BY THE DEPARTMENT AT LEAST 25
- 9 HOURS OF PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT UNDER
- 10 SUBSECTION (9) THAT COVERS COUNSELING ABOUT THE COLLEGE PREPARATION
- 11 AND SELECTION PROCESS AND AT LEAST 25 HOURS OF PROFESSIONAL
- 12 DEVELOPMENT APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT UNDER SUBSECTION (9)
- 13 COVERING CAREER COUNSELING. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION,
- 14 CAREER COUNSELING INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, EXPLORATION OF
- 15 THE SKILLED TRADES AS WELL AS OTHER CAREERS AND PATHWAYS THAT LEAD
- 16 TO INDUSTRY CREDENTIALS AWARDED IN RECOGNITION OF AN INDIVIDUAL'S
- 17 ATTAINMENT OF MEASURABLE TECHNICAL OR OCCUPATIONAL SKILLS NECESSARY
- 18 TO OBTAIN EMPLOYMENT OR ADVANCE WITHIN AN OCCUPATION.
- 19 (8) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY COMPLETE THE PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT
- 20 HOURS FOR THE PURPOSES OF SUBSECTION (7) AS PART OF THE
- 21 PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROVIDED BY A SCHOOL DISTRICT,
- 22 INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY, OR NONPUBLIC
- 23 SCHOOL UNDER SECTION 1527 IF THE CONTENT AND CURRICULUM OF THE
- 24 PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROVIDED UNDER SECTION 1527 ARE APPROVED
- 25 BY THE DEPARTMENT UNDER SUBSECTION (9).
- 26 (9) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL APPROVE THE PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT
- 27 FOR THE PURPOSES OF SUBSECTION (7). THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ONLY

- 1 APPROVE A PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM OR COURSE FOR THE
- 2 PURPOSES OF SUBSECTION (7) IF THE DEPARTMENT DETERMINES THAT THE
- 3 CONTENT AND CURRICULUM FOR THE PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT MEET
- 4 STANDARDS THAT ARE DEVELOPED BY THE DEPARTMENT IN CONSULTATION WITH
- 5 THE DEPARTMENT OF TALENT AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND GROUPS
- 6 REPRESENTING SCHOOL COUNSELORS, COLLEGE ADMISSIONS PROFESSIONALS,
- 7 FINANCIAL AID OFFICERS, EMPLOYERS, AND OTHERS AS DETERMINED
- 8 APPROPRIATE BY THE DEPARTMENT. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP THESE
- 9 STANDARDS BY DECEMBER 1, 2017 AND SHALL FACILITATE THE INVOLVEMENT
- 10 IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE STANDARDS OF THE GROUPS REQUIRED UNDER
- 11 THIS SUBSECTION.
- 12 (10) THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION SHALL PROMULGATE
- OR MODIFY RULES AS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT SUBSECTIONS (7) TO (9).
- 14 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 15 after the date it is enacted into law.
