CHAPTER	

Sec. 27a. (1) Notwithstanding section 27, in a criminal case in which the defendant is accused of committing a listed offense, against a minor, evidence that the defendant committed another listed offense against a minor—is admissible and may be considered for its bearing on any matter to which it is relevant. If the prosecuting attorney intends to offer evidence under this section, the prosecuting attorney shall disclose the evidence to the defendant at least—NOT LESS THAN 15 days before the scheduled date
