HOUSE BILL No. 4215

by amending section 676 (MCL 257.676), as amended by 2003 PA 184.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 676. (1) A person shall not allow a motor vehicle to stand on a highway unattended without engaging the parking brake or 3 placing the vehicle in park and stopping the motor of the vehicle. If the vehicle is standing upon a grade, the front wheels of the vehicle shall be turned to the curb or side of the highway.
 - (2) R 28.1458 OF THE MICHIGAN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE IS RESCINDED.
 - (3) THIS SECTION DOES NOT MODIFY THE OBLIGATION OF AN INSURER TO REIMBURSE A CLAIMANT FOR THEFT OF A MOTOR VEHICLE AS PROVIDED IN THE INSURANCE CODE OF 1956, 1956 PA 218, MCL 500.100 TO 500.8302.
 - (4) (2)—A person who violates this section SUBSECTION (1) is
