A bill to amend 1984 PA 431, entitled "The management and budget act,"

(MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594) by adding section 282a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 282A. (1) BEFORE SEEKING APPROVAL FROM THE CIVIL SERVICE
- 2 COMMISSION FOR PRIVATIZING ANY SERVICES THAT REPLACE SERVICES
- 3 PERFORMED BY STATE EMPLOYEES, A STATE AGENCY SHALL SUBMIT A
- 4 DETAILED PREPRIVATIZATION COST-BENEFIT ANALYSIS TO THE
- 5 APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEES OF THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF
- 6 REPRESENTATIVES. THE ANALYSIS MUST BE PREPARED UTILIZING ACCURATE,
- 7 RELIABLE, AND OBJECTIVE DATA AND MUST USE THE SOUNDEST ACTUARIAL
- 8 TECHNIQUES THAT ARE AVAILABLE TO THE STATE AGENCY. THE ANALYSIS
- 9 MUST INCLUDE A DETAILED COMPARATIVE ESTIMATE OF THE COSTS THAT THIS
- 10 STATE WOULD INCUR FOR THE PERIOD OF THE PROPOSED CONTRACT UNDER THE
- 11 FOLLOWING CIRCUMSTANCES:

- 10 THAT WILL PROVIDE SERVICES COVERED BY PERFORMANCE BONDS.
- 11 (2) A STATE AGENCY SHALL NOT PROCEED WITH PRIVATIZATION OF
- 12 SERVICES UNDER THIS SECTION UNTIL IT RECEIVES COST ESTIMATES AND
- 13 RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CHANGES IN WORK PROCESSES FROM THE STATE
- 14 EMPLOYEES WHO ARE PERFORMING THE SERVICES OR THEIR REPRESENTATIVES
- 15 AND GIVES FULL AND FAIR CONSIDERATION OF THE REVISED COST ESTIMATES
- 16 AND RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CHANGES IN WORK PROCESSES.
- 17 (3) THE STATE AGENCY SHALL PUBLISH A COPY OF THE DETAILED
- 18 PREPRIVATIZATION COST-BENEFIT ANALYSIS ON THE STATE AGENCY'S
- 19 WEBSITE.
