

# HOUSE BILL No. 4293

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled  
"The revised school code,"  
(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1164.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1        SEC. 1164. THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR BOARD OF  
2        DIRECTORS OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL ENSURE THAT EACH SCHOOL  
3        IT OPERATES PROVIDES INSTRUCTION TO PUPILS AT ALL GRADE LEVELS  
4        OPERATED BY THAT SCHOOL REGARDING AFRICAN-AMERICAN HISTORY AND THE  
5        CONTRIBUTIONS MADE BY AFRICAN-AMERICANS IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE  
6        UNITED STATES AND THE WORLD.

7        Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days  
8        after the date it is enacted into law.
