A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled

"The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 451a (MCL 750.451a).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 451a. Sections 448, 449, 449a, 450, and 451, AND 459 do
- 2 not apply to a law enforcement officer while in the performance of
- 3 his THE OFFICER'S duties as a law enforcement officer, UNLESS THE
- 4 OFFICER ENGAGES IN SEXUAL PENETRATION AS THAT TERM IS DEFINED IN
- 5 SECTION 520A WHILE IN THE COURSE OF HIS OR HER DUTIES.
- 6 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
 - after the date it is enacted into law.
