OF PART 72 IF THE PHARMACIST HAS A REASONABLE AND GOOD-FAITH BELIEF

THAT THE PRESCRIPTION WAS NOT WRITTEN BY A PRESCRIBER IN GOOD FAITH

OR HAS A REASONABLE AND GOOD-FAITH BELIEF THAT THE PRESCRIPTION IS

BEING FILLED FOR A PURPOSE THAT IS NOT A LEGITIMATE MEDICAL

SEC. 17751A. (1) A PHARMACIST MAY REFUSE TO DISPENSE A

(2) A PHARMACIST WHO REFUSES TO DISPENSE A PRESCRIPTION AS
PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (1) IS NOT LIABLE FOR DAMAGES IN A CIVIL
ACTION FOR INJURY, DEATH, OR LOSS TO PERSON OR PROPERTY ARISING
FROM THE PHARMACIST'S REFUSAL TO DISPENSE THE PRESCRIPTION.
