HOUSE BILL No. 4585

May 4, 2017, Introduced by Reps. Yaroch, Schor and Kesto and referred to the Committee on Law and Justice.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 479d.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 479D. (1) A PERSON WHO COMMITS OR ATTEMPTS TO COMMIT A
- 2 FELONY IN WHICH THE VICTIM IS TARGETED BECAUSE HE OR SHE IS, OR IS
- 3 PERCEIVED TO BE, A POLICE OFFICER, FIREFIGHTER, OR EMERGENCY
 - MEDICAL SERVICES PERSONNEL IS GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY
- 5 IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 2 YEARS, TO BE SERVED CONSECUTIVELY
 - TO ANY TERM OF IMPRISONMENT IMPOSED FOR THE UNDERLYING FELONY OR
- 7 ATTEMPTED FELONY.
