

# HOUSE BILL No. 4747

June 13, 2017, Introduced by Reps. LaSata, Calley, Marino, Lilly and Brann and referred to the Committee on Elections and Ethics.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled  
"Michigan election law,"  
by amending section 351 (MCL 168.351).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 351. After the filing of a nominating petition **OR FILING**  
2 **FEE** by or ~~in~~**ON** behalf of a proposed candidate for a township  
3 office, ~~such~~**THE** candidate ~~shall~~**IS** not be permitted to withdraw  
4 unless a written notice of withdrawal is served on the township  
5 clerk not later than 4 ~~o'clock, eastern standard time, in the~~  
6 ~~afternoon~~**P.M.** of the third day after the last day for filing ~~such~~  
7 **NOMINATING** petitions **OR A FILING FEE** as **PROVIDED** in this act,  
8 ~~provided,~~ unless the third day falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or  
9 legal holiday, in which case the notice of withdrawal may be served  
10 on the clerk up to 4 ~~o'clock, eastern standard time, P.M.~~ on the

1 next secular day.

2 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days  
3 after the date it is enacted into law.

4 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect  
5 unless all of the following bills of the 99th Legislature are
