A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law," by amending section 351 (MCL 168.351).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 351. After the filing of a nominating petition OR FILING 2 FEE by or in ON behalf of a proposed candidate for a township 3 office, such THE candidate shall IS not be permitted to withdraw unless a written notice of withdrawal is served on the township 4 clerk not later than 4 o'clock, eastern standard time, in the 5 6 afternoon P.M. of the third day after the last day for filing such NOMINATING petitions OR A FILING FEE as PROVIDED in this act, provided, unless the third day falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or 8 9 legal holiday, in which case the notice of withdrawal may be served on the clerk up to 4 o'clock, eastern standard time, P.M. on the
