HOUSE BILL No. 4897

September 6, 2017, Introduced by Rep. Kosowski and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 35, entitled
"The forensic laboratory funding act,"
by amending sections 3, 7, and 8 (MCL 12.203, 12.207, and 12.208),
section 7 as amended by 2003 PA 99.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 3. The state forensic laboratory fund is created as a

separate fund in the state treasury. The state treasurer shall credit to the fund all amounts received under sections 6 and 9 AND SECTION 811 OF THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.811.

Money in the fund credited to the department of state police pursuant to UNDER section 7 that is not appropriated in a fiscal year shall be credited to the fund to the credit of the department of state police and shall not revert to the general fund. Earnings

- 1 from the fund shall be credited to the fund.
- 2 Sec. 7. (1) Beginning October 1, 2003, the department of
- 3 treasury, each month, shall distribute proceeds of the state
- 4 laboratory fund that are received from the justice system fund
- 5 under section 181 of the revised judicature act of 1961, 1961 PA
- 6 236, MCL 600.181, as follows:
- 7 (a) For the state fiscal year beginning October 1, 2003, 19%
- 8 to the department of state police to defray the cost of complying
- 9 with the requirements of DNA profiling and DNA retention under the
- 10 DNA identification profiling system act, 1990 PA 250, MCL 28.171 to
- 11 28.176, with the balance of the fund being available for
- 12 distribution under subsections (2) to $\frac{(5).(6)}{.}$
- 13 (b) For the state fiscal year beginning October 1, 2004 and
- 14 subsequent state fiscal years, 45% to the department of state
- 15 police to defray the cost of complying with the requirements of DNA
- 16 profiling and DNA retention under the DNA identification profiling
- 17 system act, 1990 PA 250, MCL 28.171 to 28.176, with the balance of
- 18 the fund being available for distribution under subsections (2) to
- 19 $\frac{(5)}{(6)}$.
- 20 (2) THE DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY SHALL DISTRIBUTE PROCEEDS OF
- 21 THE STATE FORENSIC LABORATORY FUND THAT ARE RECEIVED UNDER SECTION
- 22 811 OF THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.811, TO THE
- 23 DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE TO ELIMINATE THE SEXUAL ASSAULT KIT
- 24 ANALYSIS BACKLOG.
- 25 (3) (2)—A municipality that maintains a forensic laboratory
- 26 and that incurred expenses for a forensic test by that laboratory
- 27 may apply for reimbursement of those expenses on a form provided by

- 1 the department of treasury.
- 2 (4) $\frac{(3)}{(3)}$ A municipality applying under subsection $\frac{(2)}{(3)}$ shall
- 3 report to the department of treasury the number of criminal
- 4 investigations in the preceding year for which the municipality's
- 5 forensic laboratory performed 1 or more forensic tests. The
- 6 department of state police shall report to the department of
- 7 treasury in the manner prescribed by that department the number of
- 8 criminal investigations in the preceding year for which the
- 9 department of state police performed 1 or more forensic tests,
- 10 whether the investigation was conducted by the department of state
- 11 police or by the law enforcement agency of a municipality. The
- 12 department of state police shall also report the number of DNA
- 13 identification profilings performed pursuant to UNDER the DNA
- 14 identification profiling system act, 1990 PA 250, MCL 28.171 to
- **15** 28.176.
- 16 (5) (4)—The number of investigations reported pursuant to
- 17 UNDER subsection (3) (4) shall exclude any investigation reported
- 18 in a previous year.
- 19 (6) (5) After the distributions under subsection SUBSECTIONS
- 20 (1) AND (2) are made, the department of treasury shall distribute
- 21 proceeds of the state forensic laboratory fund annually to a
- 22 municipality applying under this section in an amount determined by
- 23 multiplying the remaining amount in the fund for that period by a
- 24 fraction, the numerator of which is the total of investigations
- 25 reported pursuant to **UNDER** subsection (3) (4) by that municipality
- 26 for that period and the denominator of which is the total of
- 27 investigations and DNA identification profilings reported pursuant

- 1 to UNDER subsection (3) (4) for that period. The balance of the
- 2 fund for that period after distributions under subsection
- 3 SUBSECTIONS (1) AND (2) and this subsection shall be credited to
- 4 the department of state police.
- 5 (7) (6) The legislature shall appropriate money in the state
- 6 forensic laboratory fund credited to the department of state police
- 7 to that department exclusively for forensic science services. The
- 8 use of money appropriated pursuant to UNDER this section may
- 9 include, but is not limited to, any of the following:
- 10 (a) Costs incurred in providing forensic tests in connection
- 11 with criminal investigations conducted within this state.
- 12 (b) Purchasing or maintaining equipment used in performing
- 13 forensic tests.
- 14 (c) Providing for the continuing education, training, and
- 15 professional development of regularly employed laboratory
- 16 personnel.
- 17 (d) Payment of expenses for implementing and performing
- 18 procedures for DNA identification profiling under the DNA
- 19 identification profiling system act, 1990 PA 250, MCL 28.171 to
- 20 28.176.
- 21 (8) (7) Money appropriated from the state forensic laboratory
- 22 fund to the division of the department of state police concerned
- 23 with forensic sciences shall be in addition to any allocations made
- 24 pursuant to existing law and is intended to enhance appropriations
- 25 from the general fund and not to replace or supplant those
- 26 appropriations.
- Sec. 8. (1) A municipality shall appropriate fees deposited in

- 1 a forensic laboratory fund established pursuant to UNDER section 4
- 2 to the forensic laboratory maintained by the municipality.
- 3 (2) Money appropriated pursuant to UNDER this section shall be
- 4 for the exclusive use of the forensic laboratory maintained by the
- 5 municipality for the same purposes described in section $\frac{7(5)(a)}{a}$
- 6 7(7)(A) to (c) and shall be in addition to any allocations made
- 7 pursuant to existing law.
- 8 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 9 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 10 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 11 unless Senate Bill No.____ or House Bill No. 4897 (request no.
- 12 03849'17) of the 99th Legislature is enacted into law.
