HOUSE BILL No. 4899

September 6, 2017, Introduced by Rep. Kosowski and referred to the Committee on Tax Policy.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 35, entitled "The forensic laboratory funding act," by amending sections 3, 7, and 8 (MCL 12.203, 12.207, and 12.208), section 7 as amended by 2003 PA 99.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 3. The state forensic laboratory fund is created as a

separate fund in the state treasury. The state treasurer shall credit to the fund all amounts received under sections 6 and 9 AND SECTION 435 OF THE INCOME TAX ACT OF 1967, 1967 PA 281, MCL 206.435. Money in the fund credited to the department of state police pursuant to section 7 that is not appropriated in a fiscal year shall be credited to the fund to the credit of the department of state police and shall not revert to the general fund. Earnings from the fund shall be credited to the fund.

Sec. 7. (1) Beginning October 1, 2003, the department of

- 15 system act, 1990 PA 250, MCL 28.171 to 28.176, with the balance of
- 16 the fund being available for distribution under subsections (2) to
- 17 $\frac{(5)}{(6)}$.
- 18 (2) THE DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY SHALL DISTRIBUTE PROCEEDS OF
- 19 THE STATE FORENSIC LABORATORY FUND THAT ARE RECEIVED UNDER SECTION
- 20 435 OF THE INCOME TAX ACT OF 1967, 1967 PA 281, MCL 206.435, TO THE
- 21 DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE TO ELIMINATE THE SEXUAL ASSAULT KIT
- 22 ANALYSIS BACKLOG.
- 23 (3) (2)—A municipality that maintains a forensic laboratory
- 24 and that incurred expenses for a forensic test by that laboratory
- 25 may apply for reimbursement of those expenses on a form provided by
- 26 the department of treasury.
- 27 (4) (3) A municipality applying under subsection (2) (3) shall

- 1 report to the department of treasury the number of criminal
- 2 investigations in the preceding year for which the municipality's
- 3 forensic laboratory performed 1 or more forensic tests. The
- 4 department of state police shall report to the department of
- 5 treasury in the manner prescribed by that department the number of
- 6 criminal investigations in the preceding year for which the
- 7 department of state police performed 1 or more forensic tests,
- 8 whether the investigation was conducted by the department of state
- 9 police or by the law enforcement agency of a municipality. The
- 10 department of state police shall also report the number of DNA
- 11 identification profilings performed pursuant to the DNA
- 12 identification profiling system act, 1990 PA 250, MCL 28.171 to
- **13** 28.176.
- 14 (5) (4) The number of investigations reported pursuant to
- 15 subsection (3) (4) shall exclude any investigation reported in a
- 16 previous year.
- 17 (6) (5) After the distributions under subsection SUBSECTIONS
- 18 (1) AND (2) are made, the department of treasury shall distribute
- 19 proceeds of the state forensic laboratory fund annually to a
- 20 municipality applying under this section in an amount determined by
- 21 multiplying the remaining amount in the fund for that period by a
- 22 fraction, the numerator of which is the total of investigations
- 23 reported pursuant to subsection $\frac{(3)}{(4)}$ by that municipality for
- 24 that period and the denominator of which is the total of
- 25 investigations and DNA identification profilings reported pursuant
- 26 to subsection (3) (4) for that period. The balance of the fund for
- 27 that period after distributions under subsection—SUBSECTIONS (1)

- 1 AND (2) and this subsection shall be credited to the department of
- 2 state police.
- 3 (7) (6)—The legislature shall appropriate money in the state
- 4 forensic laboratory fund credited to the department of state police
- 5 to that department exclusively for forensic science services. The
- 6 use of money appropriated pursuant to this section may include, but
- 7 is not limited to, any of the following:
- 8 (a) Costs incurred in providing forensic tests in connection
- 9 with criminal investigations conducted within this state.
- 10 (b) Purchasing or maintaining equipment used in performing
- 11 forensic tests.
- 12 (c) Providing for the continuing education, training, and
- 13 professional development of regularly employed laboratory
- 14 personnel.
- 15 (d) Payment of expenses for implementing and performing
- 16 procedures for DNA identification profiling under the DNA
- 17 identification profiling system act, 1990 PA 250, MCL 28.171 to
- **18** 28.176.
- 19 (8) (7) Money appropriated from the state forensic laboratory
- 20 fund to the division of the department of state police concerned
- 21 with forensic sciences shall be in addition to any allocations made
- 22 pursuant to existing law and is intended to enhance appropriations
- 23 from the general fund and not to replace or supplant those
- 24 appropriations.
- 25 Sec. 8. (1) A municipality shall appropriate fees deposited in
- 26 a forensic laboratory fund established pursuant to section 4 to the
- 27 forensic laboratory maintained by the municipality.

- 1 (2) Money appropriated pursuant to this section shall be for
- 2 the exclusive use of the forensic laboratory maintained by the
- 3 municipality for the same purposes described in section $\frac{7(5)(a)}{a}$
- 4 7(7)(A) to (c) and shall be in addition to any allocations made
- 5 pursuant to existing law.
- 6 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 7 unless Senate Bill No. ____ or House Bill No. 4899 (request no.
- 8 03823'17) of the 99th Legislature is enacted into law.
