

# HOUSE BILL No. 4907

September 7, 2017, Introduced by Reps. Victory, Hoadley, Canfield, Miller, Rendon, Whiteford, Hoitenga and Vaupel and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled  
"Michigan vehicle code,"  
by amending section 811f (MCL 257.811f), as amended by 2006 PA 562.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 811f. (1) The secretary of state may, upon application,  
2       issue 1 fund-raising plate instead of a standard registration plate  
3       to a person for use on a passenger motor vehicle, ~~or motor home, or~~  
4       a pickup truck, or van. ~~used exclusively to transport personal~~  
5       ~~possessions or family members for nonbusiness purposes.~~

6       (2) A person may be issued a fund-raising plate for use on a  
7       vehicle under this act by applying to the secretary of state  
8       ~~pursuant to~~ **UNDER** section 217. ~~An~~ **THE APPLICANT MUST ACCOMPANY AN**  
9       application for an original fund-raising plate ~~shall be accompanied~~  
10      by a \$25.00 fund-raising donation, payment of the regular vehicle

1 registration tax prescribed under this act, and a \$10.00 service  
2 fee. ~~An~~ **THE APPLICANT MUST ACCOMPANY AN** application for renewal of  
3 a fund-raising plate ~~shall be accompanied by~~ payment of the vehicle  
4 registration tax required under section 801 and a \$10.00 fund-  
5 raising donation. ~~Application~~ **THE APPLICANT MUST ACCOMPANY AN**  
6 **APPLICATION** for a replacement fund-raising plate ~~shall be~~  
7 ~~accompanied by~~ **WITH** payment of only the fee prescribed under  
8 section 804.

9 (3) The secretary of state may issue a personalized fund-  
10 raising plate upon application and the payment of the personalized  
11 registration plate fee prescribed under section 803b in addition to  
12 the fees and donations prescribed under subsection (2) and the  
13 regular vehicle registration tax prescribed under this act.

14 (4) A disabled person who applies for a fund-raising plate  
15 under this section and who pays the required service fees shall be  
16 issued, as determined by the secretary of state, a disabled  
17 person's plate as provided in section 803d for his or her fund-  
18 raising plate. The secretary of state shall require the same proof  
19 that the applicant is a disabled person as is required for issuance  
20 of a permanent windshield placard under section 675.

21 (5) A fund-raising plate expires ~~pursuant to~~ **AS PROVIDED IN**  
22 section 226. The secretary of state may issue a tab or tabs  
23 designating the month and year of expiration for an original or  
24 renewal fund-raising plate.

25 (6) The secretary of state may issue a temporary registration  
26 permit to a person who submits an application and the proper fees  
27 and donation for a fund-raising plate, if the applicant's current

1 vehicle registration will expire before his or her receipt of a  
2 fund-raising plate. The temporary registration ~~shall expire~~ **EXPIRES**  
3 upon the applicant's receipt of a fund-raising plate or upon the  
4 expiration of 30 days after the date of issuance, whichever occurs  
5 first. The **SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL ISSUE THE** temporary permit  
6 ~~shall be issued without a separate fee.~~

7 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days  
8 after the date it is enacted into law.
