- 4 2007 AND DECEMBER 31, 2016 IN ASSOCIATION WITH A CLAIM FOR
- 5 UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS UNDER THE MICHIGAN EMPLOYMENT SECURITY ACT,
- 6 1936 (EX SESS) PA 1, MCL 421.1 TO 421.75, THE CAUSE OF ACTION

- 1 UNEMPLOYMENT AGENCY OF THE ACCUSATION. ACTUAL NOTICE DOES NOT
