- 3 APPARATUS, AMBULANCES, AND POLICE PATROL VEHICLES AT A STREET OR
- 4 HIGHWAY INTERSECTION WITHIN THIS STATE IF THE MOTORCYCLE DISPLAYS A
- 5 FLAG THAT IS FLUORESCENT ORANGE IN COLOR. THE LEAD MOTORCYCLE AND
 - THE LAST MOTORCYCLE IN THE MOTORCYCLE PROCESSION MAY CARRY AN
- 7 ADDITIONAL FLAG. THE FLAGS DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION SHALL NOT
- 8 BE EMBOSSED OR PRINTED WITH A NAME.
- 9 (2) A PERSON PASSING THROUGH A MOTORCYCLE PROCESSION
- 10 DESIGNATED UNDER SUBSECTION (1) WITH A VEHICLE OF ANY KIND IS
