## **HOUSE BILL No. 5036**

September 27, 2017, Introduced by Reps. Miller, Howrylak, Graves, Hoadley and Chang and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 5145.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 5145. (1) THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON PEDIATRIC AUTOIMMUNE
- 2 NEUROPSYCHIATRIC DISORDER ASSOCIATED WITH STREPTOCOCCAL INFECTIONS
- 3 IS CREATED WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT.
  - (2) THE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL CONSIST OF THE FOLLOWING 15 MEMBERS, APPOINTED BY THE DIRECTOR:
- 6 (A) AN IMMUNOLOGIST WHO IS PRACTICING IN THIS STATE AND HAS
- 7 EXPERIENCE TREATING INDIVIDUALS WITH PEDIATRIC AUTOIMMUNE
- 8 NEUROPSYCHIATRIC DISORDER ASSOCIATED WITH STREPTOCOCCAL INFECTIONS
- 9 AND PEDIATRIC ACUTE NEUROPSYCHIATRIC SYNDROME AND THE USE OF
- 10 INTRAVENOUS IMMUNOGLOBULIN.

- 1 (B) A HEALTH PROFESSIONAL WHO IS LICENSED UNDER ARTICLE 15 WHO
- 2 HAS EXPERTISE IN TREATING INDIVIDUALS WITH PEDIATRIC AUTOIMMUNE
- 3 NEUROPSYCHIATRIC DISORDER ASSOCIATED WITH STREPTOCOCCAL INFECTIONS
- 4 AND PEDIATRIC ACUTE NEUROPSYCHIATRIC SYNDROME AND AUTISM.
- 5 (C) A REPRESENTATIVE OF PANDAS/PANS ADVOCACY AND SUPPORT.
- 6 (D) A PHYSICIAN WHO IS LICENSED UNDER ARTICLE 15 TO ENGAGE IN
- 7 THE PRACTICE OF OSTEOPATHIC MEDICINE AND SURGERY WHO HAS EXPERIENCE
- 8 TREATING INDIVIDUALS WITH PEDIATRIC AUTOIMMUNE NEUROPSYCHIATRIC
- 9 DISORDER ASSOCIATED WITH STREPTOCOCCAL INFECTIONS AND PEDIATRIC
- 10 ACUTE NEUROPSYCHIATRIC SYNDROME.
- 11 (E) A MEDICAL RESEARCHER WITH EXPERIENCE CONDUCTING RESEARCH
- 12 CONCERNING PEDIATRIC AUTOIMMUNE NEUROPSYCHIATRIC DISORDER
- 13 ASSOCIATED WITH STREPTOCOCCAL INFECTIONS, PEDIATRIC ACUTE
- 14 NEUROPSYCHIATRIC SYNDROME, OBSESSIVE-COMPULSIVE DISORDER, TIC
- 15 DISORDER, AND OTHER NEUROLOGICAL DISORDERS.
- 16 (F) A DIETITIAN WHO IS PRACTICING IN THIS STATE AND WHO
- 17 PROVIDES SERVICES TO CHILDREN WITH AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER,
- 18 ATTENTION-DEFICIT HYPERACTIVITY DISORDER, AND OTHER NEURO-
- 19 DEVELOPMENTAL CONDITIONS.
- 20 (G) A REPRESENTATIVE OF A PROFESSIONAL ORGANIZATION IN THIS
- 21 STATE FOR SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGISTS.
- 22 (H) A CHILD PSYCHIATRIST WHO HAS EXPERIENCE TREATING
- 23 INDIVIDUALS WITH PEDIATRIC AUTOIMMUNE NEUROPSYCHIATRIC DISORDER
- 24 ASSOCIATED WITH STREPTOCOCCAL INFECTIONS AND PEDIATRIC ACUTE
- 25 NEUROPSYCHIATRIC SYNDROME.
- 26 (I) A REPRESENTATIVE OF A PROFESSIONAL ORGANIZATION IN THIS
- 27 STATE FOR SCHOOL NURSES.

- 1 (J) A PEDIATRICIAN WHO HAS EXPERIENCE TREATING INDIVIDUALS
- 2 WITH PEDIATRIC AUTOIMMUNE NEUROPSYCHIATRIC DISORDER ASSOCIATED WITH
- 3 STREPTOCOCCAL INFECTIONS AND PEDIATRIC ACUTE NEUROPSYCHIATRIC
- 4 SYNDROME.
- 5 (K) A REPRESENTATIVE OF AN ORGANIZATION FOCUSED ON AUTISM.
- 6 (1) A PARENT OF A CHILD WHO HAS BEEN DIAGNOSED WITH PEDIATRIC
- 7 AUTOIMMUNE NEUROPSYCHIATRIC DISORDER ASSOCIATED WITH STREPTOCOCCAL
- 8 INFECTIONS OR PEDIATRIC ACUTE NEUROPSYCHIATRIC SYNDROME AND AUTISM.
- 9 (M) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS LICENSED UNDER ARTICLE 15 AS A
- 10 LICENSED MASTER'S SOCIAL WORKER OR LICENSED BACHELOR'S SOCIAL
- 11 WORKER.
- 12 (N) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE OFFICE OF SPECIAL EDUCATION WITHIN
- 13 THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.
- 14 (O) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC.
- 15 (3) THE DIRECTOR, OR HIS OR HER DESIGNEE, SHALL SERVE AS AN EX
- 16 OFFICIO MEMBER OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL WITHOUT THE RIGHT TO VOTE.
- 17 (4) THE MEMBERS FIRST APPOINTED TO THE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL
- 18 BE APPOINTED WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS
- 19 SECTION.
- 20 (5) MEMBERS OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL SERVE FOR TERMS OF 4
- 21 YEARS OR UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED, WHICHEVER IS LATER, EXCEPT
- 22 THAT OF THE MEMBERS FIRST APPOINTED 5 SHALL SERVE FOR 1 YEAR, 5
- 23 SHALL SERVE FOR 2 YEARS, AND 5 SHALL SERVE FOR 3 YEARS.
- 24 (6) IF A VACANCY OCCURS ON THE ADVISORY COUNCIL, THE DIRECTOR
- 25 SHALL MAKE AN APPOINTMENT FOR THE UNEXPIRED TERM IN THE SAME MANNER
- 26 AS THE ORIGINAL APPOINTMENT.
- 27 (7) THE DIRECTOR MAY REMOVE A MEMBER OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL

- 1 FOR INCOMPETENCE, DERELICTION OF DUTY, MALFEASANCE, MISFEASANCE, OR
- 2 NONFEASANCE IN OFFICE, OR ANY OTHER GOOD CAUSE.
- 3 (8) THE FIRST MEETING OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL BE CALLED
- 4 BY THE DIRECTOR WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS
- 5 SECTION. AT THE FIRST MEETING, THE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL ELECT
- 6 FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS A CHAIRPERSON AND OTHER OFFICERS AS IT
- 7 CONSIDERS NECESSARY OR APPROPRIATE. AFTER THE FIRST MEETING, THE
- 8 ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL MEET AT THE CALL OF THE CHAIRPERSON OR IF
- 9 REQUESTED BY A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL.
- 10 (9) A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL
- 11 CONSTITUTE A QUORUM FOR THE TRANSACTION OF BUSINESS AT A MEETING OF
- 12 THE ADVISORY COUNCIL. A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS PRESENT AND SERVING
- 13 ARE REQUIRED FOR OFFICIAL ACTION OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL.
- 14 (10) THE BUSINESS THAT THE ADVISORY COUNCIL MAY PERFORM SHALL
- 15 BE CONDUCTED AT A PUBLIC MEETING OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL HELD IN
- 16 COMPLIANCE WITH THE OPEN MEETINGS ACT, 1976 PA 267, MCL 15.261 TO
- 17 15.275.
- 18 (11) A WRITING PREPARED, OWNED, USED, IN THE POSSESSION OF, OR
- 19 RETAINED BY THE ADVISORY COUNCIL IN THE PERFORMANCE OF AN OFFICIAL
- 20 FUNCTION IS SUBJECT TO THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT, 1976 PA 442,
- 21 MCL 15.231 TO 15.246.
- 22 (12) MEMBERS OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL SERVE WITHOUT
- 23 COMPENSATION. HOWEVER, MEMBERS OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL MAY BE
- 24 REIMBURSED FOR THEIR ACTUAL AND NECESSARY EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE
- 25 PERFORMANCE OF THEIR OFFICIAL DUTIES AS MEMBERS OF THE ADVISORY
- 26 COUNCIL.
- 27 (13) BY JANUARY 1, 2019, AND ANNUALLY THEREAFTER, THE ADVISORY

- 1 COUNCIL SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE WITH
- 2 RECOMMENDATIONS ON ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 3 (A) PRACTICE GUIDELINES FOR THE DIAGNOSIS AND TREATMENT OF
- 4 PEDIATRIC AUTOIMMUNE NEUROPSYCHIATRIC DISORDER ASSOCIATED WITH
- 5 STREPTOCOCCAL INFECTIONS AND PEDIATRIC ACUTE NEUROPSYCHIATRIC
- 6 SYNDROME.
- 7 (B) MECHANISMS TO INCREASE CLINICAL AWARENESS AND EDUCATION
- 8 REGARDING PEDIATRIC AUTOIMMUNE NEUROPSYCHIATRIC DISORDER ASSOCIATED
- 9 WITH STREPTOCOCCAL INFECTIONS AND PEDIATRIC ACUTE NEUROPSYCHIATRIC
- 10 SYNDROME AMONG PHYSICIANS, SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS, AND
- 11 PROVIDERS OF MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES.
- 12 (C) OUTREACH TO EDUCATORS AND PARENTS TO INCREASE AWARENESS OF
- 13 PEDIATRIC AUTOIMMUNE NEUROPSYCHIATRIC DISORDER ASSOCIATED WITH
- 14 STREPTOCOCCAL INFECTIONS AND PEDIATRIC ACUTE NEUROPSYCHIATRIC
- 15 SYNDROME.
- 16 (D) DEVELOPMENT OF A NETWORK OF VOLUNTEER EXPERTS ON THE
- 17 DIAGNOSIS AND TREATMENT OF PEDIATRIC AUTOIMMUNE NEUROPSYCHIATRIC
- 18 DISORDER ASSOCIATED WITH STREPTOCOCCAL INFECTIONS AND PEDIATRIC
- 19 ACUTE NEUROPSYCHIATRIC SYNDROME TO ASSIST IN EDUCATION AND
- 20 OUTREACH.
- 21 (E) ANY OTHER RECOMMENDATION THAT THE ADVISORY COUNCIL
- 22 CONSIDERS APPROPRIATE.
- 23 (14) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "ADVISORY COUNCIL" MEANS THE
- 24 ADVISORY COUNCIL ON PEDIATRIC AUTOIMMUNE NEUROPSYCHIATRIC DISORDER
- 25 ASSOCIATED WITH STREPTOCOCCAL INFECTIONS CREATED IN SUBSECTION (1).
- 26 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 27 after the date it is enacted into law.
