A bill to amend 2008 PA 23, entitled

"Enhanced driver license and enhanced official state personal identification card act,"

by amending section 4 (MCL 28.304).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4. (1) The secretary of state may issue an enhanced
- 2 driver's license or enhanced official state personal identification
- 3 card to an applicant who provides satisfactory proof of his or her
- 4 full legal name, United States citizenship, identity, date of
- 5 birth, social security number, residence address, and a
- 6 photographic identity document. An applicant may choose to apply
- for a standard driver license or standard official state personal
- identification card or an enhanced driver license or enhanced state

- 1 personal identification card.
- 2 (2) An enhanced driver license or enhanced official state
- 3 personal identification card shall include reasonable security
- 4 measures to protect against unauthorized disclosure of personal
- 5 information regarding residents of this state that is contained in
- 6 the enhanced driver license or enhanced official state personal
- 7 identification card.
- 8 (3) An enhanced driver license or enhanced official state
- 9 personal identification card may include radio frequency
- 10 identification technology that is limited to a randomly assigned
- 11 number, which shall be encrypted if agreed to by the department of
- 12 homeland security, DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, and does not
- 13 include biometric data. The secretary of state shall ensure that

- 2 in this subsection, "licensing sanction" means the restriction,
- 3 suspension, revocation, or denial of a driver license; the addition
- 4 of points to a driving record; UNTIL OCTOBER 1, 2018, the
- 5 assessment of a driver responsibility fee; the assessment of a
- 6 civil fine or criminal penalty resulting from a conviction; a civil
- 7 infraction determination; the imposition of probationary terms and
- 8 conditions; or any other penalty provided under the Michigan
- 9 vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 to 257.923.
- 10 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 11 after the date it is enacted into law.
