## **HOUSE BILL No. 5053**

October 3, 2017, Introduced by Reps. Noble, Rendon, Bellino, Runestad, Lucido, Wentworth, Barrett, Glenn and Hornberger and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend 1968 PA 2, entitled "Uniform budgeting and accounting act,"

(MCL 141.421 to 141.440a) by adding sections 16a, 16b, 16c, 16d, and 16e.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 16A. THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF A LOCAL UNIT SHALL NOT ADOPT
- 2 A GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT OR AN AMENDMENT TO THAT GENERAL
- 3 APPROPRIATIONS ACT, OR A LAW, CHARTER, RESOLUTION, OR ORDINANCE,
- 4 THAT PROVIDES ANY FUNDING TO SPECIFICALLY SUPPORT OR OTHERWISE
- 5 ASSIST ILLEGAL ALIENS.
- 6 SEC. 16B. NOT LATER THAN 60 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF
- 7 THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED SECTION 16A, IF A LOCAL UNIT HAS AN
- 8 EXISTING GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT, AMENDMENT TO A GENERAL
  - APPROPRIATIONS ACT, LAW, CHARTER, RESOLUTION, OR ORDINANCE THAT

- 16 COMPLAINTS. A LOCAL UNIT SHALL COOPERATE WITH ANY INVESTIGATION
- 17 CONDUCTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL CONCERNING A

- 19 (2) BEGINNING 61 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE

- 1 DESCRIBED IN SECTION 16D, AND THE COURT DETERMINES THAT ANY
- 2 PROVISION OF THE GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT, AMENDMENT TO A GENERAL
- 3 APPROPRIATIONS ACT, LAW, CHARTER, RESOLUTION, OR ORDINANCE OF THE
- 4 LOCAL UNIT VIOLATES SECTION 16A, THE COURT SHALL DO ALL OF THE

- 13 (C) AWARD ACTUAL DAMAGES, COSTS, AND REASONABLE ATTORNEY FEES
- 14 TO THE PARTY CHALLENGING THE GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT, AMENDMENT
- 15 TO A GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT, LAW, CHARTER, RESOLUTION, OR

- 17 (2) IN ADDITION TO THE REQUIREMENTS UNDER SUBSECTION (1), IF
