## **HOUSE BILL No. 5100**

October 12, 2017, Introduced by Reps. Hughes, Marino, Lucido, Reilly and Gay-Dagnogo and referred to the Committee on Tourism and Outdoor Recreation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled

"Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 225 (MCL 257.225), as amended by 2014 PA 26.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 225. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection and subsection (6), a registration plate issued for a vehicle shall be attached to the rear of the vehicle. A registration plate issued for a truck tractor or road tractor shall be attached to the front of the vehicle.

(2) A registration plate shall at all times be securely fastened in a horizontal position to the vehicle for which the plate is issued so as to prevent the plate from swinging. The plate shall be attached at a height of not less than 12 inches from the ground, measured from the bottom of the plate, in a place and position that is clearly visible. - 16 (4) A person shall not attach a name plate, insignia, or
- 17 advertising device to a registration plate in a manner that
- 18 obscures or partially obscures the registration information.
- 19 (5) A person shall not operate a motor vehicle that has a name
- 20 plate, insignia, or advertising device attached to a registration
- 21 plate in a manner that obscures or partially obscures the
- 22 registration information.
- 23 (6) A registration plate issued for a historic military
- 24 vehicle that is authorized to be operated on the roads of this
- 25 state is not required to be attached to the rear or the front of
- 26 the historic military vehicle unless the historic military vehicle
- 27 was originally manufactured with lighting and mounting provisions

- 2 attached to the exterior of the historic military vehicle, it shall
- 3 be present in the historic military vehicle to which it refers and
- 4 shall be made available upon demand of a police officer. As used in
- 5 this subsection, "historic military vehicle" means a vehicle,
- 6 including a trailer, regardless of the vehicle's size, weight, or
- 7 year of manufacture, that was manufactured for use in any country's
- 8 military forces and is maintained to represent its military design
- 9 and markings accurately.
- 10 (7) A person who violates this section is responsible for a
- 11 civil infraction.
- 12 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 13 after the date it is enacted into law.
