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## **HOUSE BILL No. 5119**

October 17, 2017, Introduced by Reps. Hammoud, Rabhi, Gay-Dagnogo, Schor, Lucido, Zemke and Pagan and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 648 (MCL 257.648), as amended by 2014 PA 1.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 648. (1) The operator of a vehicle or bicycle upon a

highway, before stopping or turning from a direct line, shall first determine that the stopping or turning can be made in safety and shall give a signal as required in this section. AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION, "TURNING FROM A DIRECT LINE" INCLUDES MOVING THE VEHICLE OR BICYCLE FROM THE TRAVELED LANE OR SHOULDER INTO AN ADJACENT LANE.

(2) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (5), a signal required under this section shall be given either by means of the hand and arm in the manner specified in this section, or by a mechanical or electrical signal device that conveys an intelligible

- 2 (3) When a person is operating a vehicle and signal is given
- 3 by means of the hand and arm, the operator shall signal as follows:
- 4 (a) For a left turn **OR WHEN MOVING THE VEHICLE INTO THE**
- 5 ADJACENT LEFT LANE, the operator shall extend his or her left hand
- 6 and arm horizontally.
- 7 (b) For a right turn OR WHEN MOVING THE VEHICLE INTO THE
- 8 ADJACENT RIGHT LANE, the operator shall extend his or her left hand
- 9 and arm upward.
- 10 (c) To stop or decrease speed, the operator shall extend his
- 11 or her left hand and arm downward.
- 12 (4) When a person is operating a bicycle and signal is given
- 13 by means of the hand and arm, the operator shall signal as follows:
- 14 (a) For a left turn OR WHEN MOVING THE BICYCLE INTO THE
- 15 ADJACENT LEFT LANE, the operator shall extend his or her left hand
- 16 and arm horizontally.
- 17 (b) For a right turn OR WHEN MOVING THE VEHICLE INTO THE
- 18 ADJACENT RIGHT LANE, the operator shall extend his or her left hand
- 19 and arm upward or shall extend his or her right hand arm
- 20 horizontally.
- 21 (c) To stop or decrease speed, the operator shall extend his
- 22 or her left hand and arm downward.
- 23 (5) A commercial motor vehicle, other than a commercial motor
- 24 vehicle in transit from a manufacturer to a dealer, in use on a
- 25 highway shall be equipped with, and required signal shall be given
- 26 by, a signal lamp or mechanical signal device when the distance
- 27 from the center of the top of the steering post to the left outside

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- 1 limit of the body, cab, or load of the commercial motor vehicle
- 2 exceeds 24 inches, or when the distance from the center of the top
- 3 of the steering post to the rear limit of the body or load of the
- 4 commercial vehicle exceeds 14 feet. The measurement from steering
- 5 post to rear limit applies to a single vehicle or combination of
- 6 vehicles.
- 7 (6) A person who violates this section is responsible for a
- 8 civil infraction.
- 9 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 10 after the date it is enacted into law.
