HOUSE BILL No. 5137

October 18, 2017, Introduced by Rep. Johnson and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding sections 204b and 204c.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 204B. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT IMPORT, MANUFACTURE,
- 2 DISTRIBUTE, OR STORE EXPLOSIVE MATERIALS IN THIS STATE, UNLESS THE
- 3 IMPORTATION, MANUFACTURE, DISTRIBUTION, OR STORAGE OF THE EXPLOSIVE
- 4 MATERIALS COMPLIES WITH 18 USC 841 TO 848 AND 27 CFR 555.
 - (2) A PERSON THAT VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
 MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 2 YEARS OR
 A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$10,000.00, OR BOTH.
- 8 (3) A CONVICTION OR SENTENCE IMPOSED FOR A VIOLATION OF THIS
- 9 SECTION DOES NOT PRECLUDE A CONVICTION OR SENTENCE FOR A VIOLATION
- 10 OF ANY OTHER APPLICABLE LAW. AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "EXPLOSIVE
 - MATERIALS" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN 18 USC 841.

- 10 (B) "CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN
- 11 SECTION 7104 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.7104.
- 12 (C) "EXPLOSIVE MATERIALS" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN 18 USC
- 13 841.
- 14 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 15 after the date it is enacted into law.
