

# HOUSE BILL No. 5148

October 19, 2017, Introduced by Reps. Chang, Camilleri, Clemente, Brinks, Faris, Pagan, Hoadley, Sowerby, Hammoud, Schor, Wittenberg, Lasinski, Geiss and Zemke and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make, supplement, and adjust appropriations for various state departments and agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018; to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

7 **GENERAL SECTIONS**

8 Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state

9 constitution of 1963, total state spending from state resources

10 under part 1 for fiscal year 2017-2018 is \$0.00 and total state

11 spending from state resources to be paid to local units of

12 government for fiscal year 2017-2018 is \$0.00.

13 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized

14 under this act and the departments, commissions, boards, offices,

15 and programs for which appropriations are made under this act are

16 subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101

18 **DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION**

19 Sec. 301. (1) From the funds appropriated in part 1 for child

20 development and care public assistance, there is allocated

21 \$19,430,000.00 for the following purposes:

22 (a) To increase the provider reimbursement rates for child

23 care centers under the following guidelines:

24 (i) Increase the reimbursement rate for child care center

1 providers with an empty star rating by \$0.15 per hour for each  
2 child.

3 (ii) Increase the reimbursement rate for child care center  
4 providers with a 1-star rating by \$0.35 per hour for each child.

5 (iii) Increase the reimbursement rate for child care center  
6 providers with a 2-star rating by \$0.45 per hour for each child.

7 (iv) Increase the reimbursement rate for child care center  
8 providers with a 3-star rating by \$0.50 per hour for each child.

9 (v) Increase the reimbursement rate for child care center  
10 providers with a 4-star rating by \$0.70 per hour for each child.

11 (vi) Increase the reimbursement rate for child care center  
12 providers with a 5-star rating by \$0.80 per hour for each child.

13 (b) To increase the provider reimbursement rates for group  
14 home providers under the following guidelines:

15 (i) Increase the reimbursement rate for group child care home  
16 providers with an empty star rating by \$0.15 per hour for each  
17 child.

18 (ii) Increase the reimbursement rate for group child care home  
19 providers with a 1-star rating by \$0.35 per hour for each child.

20 (iii) Increase the reimbursement rate for group child care  
21 home providers with a 2-star rating by \$0.45 per hour for each  
22 child.

23 (iv) Increase the reimbursement rate for group child care home  
24 providers with a 3-star rating by \$0.50 per hour for each child.

25 (v) Increase the reimbursement rate for group child care home  
26 providers with a 4-star rating by \$0.70 per hour for each child.

27 (vi) Increase the reimbursement rate for group child care home

1 providers with a 5-star rating by \$0.80 per hour for each child.

2 (c) To increase the provider reimbursement rates for  
3 registered family child care homes under the following guidelines:

4 (i) Increase the reimbursement rate for registered family  
5 child care home providers with an empty star rating by \$0.15 per  
6 hour for each child.

7 (ii) Increase the reimbursement rate for registered family  
8 child care home providers with a 1-star rating by \$0.35 per hour  
9 for each child.

10 (iii) Increase the reimbursement rate for registered family  
11 child care home providers with a 2-star rating by \$0.45 per hour  
12 for each child.

13 (iv) Increase the reimbursement rate for registered family  
14 child care home providers with a 3-star rating by \$0.50 per hour  
15 for each child.

16 (v) Increase the reimbursement rate for registered family  
17 child care home providers with a 4-star rating by \$0.70 per hour  
18 for each child.

19 (vi) Increase the reimbursement rate for registered family  
20 child care home providers with a 5-star rating by \$0.80 per hour  
21 for each child.

22 (d) To increase the provider reimbursement rates for  
23 unlicensed providers under the following guidelines:

24 (i) Increase the reimbursement rate for unlicensed providers  
25 with a tier 1 rating by \$0.25 per hour for each child.

26 (ii) Increase the reimbursement rate for unlicensed providers  
27 with a tier 2 rating by \$0.75 per hour for each child.

1           (2) The department shall ensure that the final provider  
2 reimbursement rates determined under this section are published on  
3 the department and great start to quality webpages by the date that  
4 the new rates take effect.

5           (3) Under the child development and care program, a child care  
6 center provider, a group child care home provider, or a family  
7 child care home provider with an empty star rating shall not be  
8 reimbursed at the same rate as or a greater rate than a child care  
9 center provider, group child care home provider, or family child  
10 care home provider with a star rating of 1 or higher.
