HOUSE BILL No. 5157

October 19, 2017, Introduced by Rep. Hornberger and referred to the Committee on Education Reform.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled

"The revised school code,"

by amending section 1284b (MCL 380.1284b), as amended by 2006 PA 235 .

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1284b. (1) Until subsection (2) applies to the school
- 2 district, public school academy, or intermediate school district,
- 3 the BEGINNING WITH THE 2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR, THE board of a school
 - district or intermediate school district or board of directors of a
 - public school academy shall ensure that the ALL OF THE FOLLOWING
- 6 ARE MET:
 - (A) THE district's or public school academy's schools are not
 - in session on the Friday before Labor day.DAY.
