- 1 SEC. 732D. (1) IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT, THE
- 2 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, THE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE
- 3 AGENCY, MICHIGAN WORKS AGENCIES, AND THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS,
- 4 THE DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY SHALL EDUCATE INDIVIDUALS WHOSE DRIVER
- 5 RESPONSIBILITY FEE OBLIGATIONS ARE AFFECTED BY CHANGES MADE TO
- 6 STATE LAW ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED
- 7 THIS SECTION. THE EDUCATION REQUIRED BY THIS SUBSECTION SHALL
