

HOUSE BILL No. 5252

November 9, 2017, Introduced by Reps. Ellison, Lucido, Gay-Dagnogo, Sneller, Wittenberg, Sabo, LaGrand, Jones and Love and referred to the Committee on Michigan Competitiveness.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled
"Michigan vehicle code,"
(MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding section 732d.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 732D. (1) IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT, THE
2 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, THE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE
3 AGENCY, MICHIGAN WORKS AGENCIES, AND THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS,
4 THE DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY SHALL EDUCATE INDIVIDUALS WHOSE DRIVER
5 RESPONSIBILITY FEE OBLIGATIONS ARE AFFECTED BY CHANGES MADE TO
6 STATE LAW ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED
7 THIS SECTION. THE EDUCATION REQUIRED BY THIS SUBSECTION SHALL
8 INCLUDE INFORMATIONAL MATERIALS AND EFFECTIVE OUTREACH.

9 (2) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2018, \$160,000.00

1 IS APPROPRIATED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY TO IMPLEMENT AND
2 ADMINISTER THIS SECTION.

3 (3) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2018,
4 \$1,000,000.00 IS APPROPRIATED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE TO
5 IMPLEMENT AND ADMINISTER AN EDUCATIONAL OUTREACH PROGRAM TO PROVIDE
6 INFORMATION REGARDING THE REQUIREMENTS TO REINSTATE AN OPERATOR'S
7 LICENSE UNDER THIS ACT.

8 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
9 after the date it is enacted into law.
