- 2 WHILE A DOG IS SITTING IN HIS OR HER LAP, UNLESS THE DOG IS SITTING
- 3 IN HIS OR HER LAP FOR A MEDICAL PURPOSE UNDER THE AMERICANS WITH
- 4 DISABILITIES ACT OF 1990, 42 USC 12101 TO 12213.
- 5 (2) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1) IS RESPONSIBLE
 - FOR A CIVIL INFRACTION AND SHALL BE ORDERED TO PAY A CIVIL FINE AS
- 7 FOLLOWS:

- (A) FOR A FIRST VIOLATION, \$100.00.
- (B) FOR A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION, \$200.00.
- 10 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
