or additions to the contract are also in writing. The contract
required under this section shall MUST contain a statement, in type
no smaller than that of the body of the contract, stating all of

- 2 (4) A CONTRACTOR WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
- 3 MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 90 DAYS OR
- 4 A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00, OR BOTH.
- 5 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 6 after the date it is enacted into law.
