THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 5. (1) The department shall promulgate and enforce rules to carry out this act pursuant to the administrative procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 to 24.328. The rules, at a minimum, shall include the following:
 - (a) Requirements for the submission of reports, plans, and specifications for the design and construction of a waterworks system or a part thereof, OF A WATERWORKS SYSTEM, and a plan for operating and maintaining all or a part of the waterworks system, including the protection of water quality within the distribution
