HOUSE BILL No. 5399

January 11, 2018, Introduced by Rep. Lucido and referred to the Committee on Insurance.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 226 (MCL 257.226), as amended by 2016 PA 425.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 226. (1) A vehicle registration issued by the secretary
- 2 of state expires on the owner's birthday, DATE THAT THE VEHICLE
- 3 INSURANCE REQUIRED UNDER CHAPTER 31 OF THE INSURANCE CODE OF 1956,
 - 1956 PA 218, MCL 500.3101 TO 500.3179, EXPIRES, unless another
- 5 expiration date is provided for under this act or unless the
- registration is for the following vehicles, in which case
- 7 registration expires on the last day of February:
- 8 (a) A commercial vehicle except for a commercial vehicle
- 9 issued a registration under the international registration plan or

- 1 a pickup truck or van owned by an individual.
- 2 (b) Except for a trailer or semitrailer issued a registration
- 3 under the international registration plan, a trailer or semitrailer
- 4 owned by a business, corporation, or person other than an
- 5 individual; or a pole trailer.
- **6** (2) The expiration date for a registration issued for a
- 7 motorcycle is the motorcycle owner's birthday.
- **8** (3) The expiration date for a registration bearing the letters
- 9 "SEN" or "REP" is February 1.
- 10 (4) In the case of a vehicle owned by a business, corporation,
- 11 or an owner other than an individual, the secretary of state may
- 12 assign or reassign the expiration date of the registration.
- 13 (5) The secretary of state shall do all of the following:
- 14 (a) After the October 1 immediately preceding the year
- 15 designated on the registration, issue a registration upon
- 16 application and payment of the proper fee for a commercial vehicle,
- 17 other than a pickup or van owned by an individual; or a trailer
- 18 owned by a business, corporation, or person other than an
- 19 individual.
- 20 (b) Beginning 60 days before the expiration date assigned on
- 21 an international registration plan registration plate, issue a
- 22 registration under section 801g upon application and payment of the
- 23 proper apportioned fee for a commercial vehicle engaged in
- 24 interstate commerce.
- 25 (c) Beginning 45 days before the owner's birthday DATE THAT
- 26 THE VEHICLE INSURANCE REQUIRED UNDER CHAPTER 31 OF THE INSURANCE
- 27 CODE OF 1956, 1956 PA 218, MCL 500.3101 TO 500.3179, EXPIRES and

- 1 120 days before the expiration date assigned by the secretary of
- 2 state, issue a registration for a vehicle other than those
- 3 designated in subsection (1)(a) or (b). However, if an owner whose
- 4 registration period begins 45 days before his or her birthday THE
- 5 DATE THAT THE VEHICLE INSURANCE REQUIRED UNDER CHAPTER 31 OF THE
- 6 INSURANCE CODE OF 1956, 1956 PA 218, MCL 500.3101 TO 500.3179,
- 7 EXPIRES will be out of the state during the 45 days immediately
- 8 preceding expiration of a registration or for other good cause
- 9 shown cannot apply for a renewal registration within the 45-day
- 10 period, application for a renewal registration may be made not more
- 11 than 6 months before expiration.
- 12 (6) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the THE
- 13 secretary of state, upon application and payment of the proper fee,
- 14 shall issue a registration for a vehicle or a motorcycle to a
- 15 resident that shall expire on the owner's birthday. If the owner's
- 16 next birthday is at least 6 months but not more than 12 months in
- 17 the future, the owner shall receive a registration valid until the
- 18 owner's next birthday. If the owner's next birthday is less than 6
- 19 months in the future, the owner shall receive a registration valid
- 20 until the owner's birthday following the owner's next birthday.
- 21 DATE THAT THE VEHICLE INSURANCE REQUIRED UNDER CHAPTER 31 OF THE
- 22 INSURANCE CODE OF 1956, 1956 PA 218, MCL 500.3101 TO 500.3179,
- 23 EXPIRES. The tax required under this act for a registration
- 24 described in this subsection shall be either of the following:
- 25 (a) For an original registration, the tax shall bear the same
- 26 relationship to the tax required under section 801 for a 12-month
- 27 registration as the length of the registration bears to 12 months.

- 1 (b) For a renewal of a registration, either of the following:
- 2 (i) For a registration that is for at least 6 months but not
- 3 more than 12 months, the same amount as for 12 months.
- 4 (ii) For a renewal of a registration that is for more than 12
- 5 months, 2 times the amount for 12 months.
- 6 Partial months shall be considered as whole months in the
- 7 calculation of the required tax and in the determination of the
- 8 length of time between the application for a registration and the
- 9 owner's next birthday. DATE THAT THE VEHICLE INSURANCE REQUIRED
- 10 UNDER CHAPTER 31 OF THE INSURANCE CODE OF 1956, 1956 PA 218, MCL
- 11 500.3101 TO 500.3179, EXPIRES. The tax required for that
- 12 registration shall be rounded off to whole dollars as provided in
- **13** section 801.
- 14 (7) A certificate of title shall remain valid until canceled
- 15 by the secretary of state for cause or upon a transfer of an
- 16 interest shown on the certificate of title.
- 17 (8) The secretary of state, upon request, shall issue special
- 18 registration for commercial vehicles, valid for 6 months after the
- 19 date of issue, if the full registration fee exceeds \$50.00, on the
- 20 payment of 1/2 the full registration fee and a service charge FEE
- 21 as enumerated in section 802(1).
- 22 (9) The secretary of state may issue a special registration
- 23 for each of the following:
- 24 (a) A new vehicle purchased or leased outside of this state
- 25 and delivered in this state to the purchaser or lessee by the
- 26 manufacturer of that vehicle for removal to a place outside of this
- 27 state, if a certification is made that the vehicle will be

- 1 primarily used, stored, and registered outside of this state and
- 2 will not be returned to this state by the purchaser or lessee for
- 3 use or storage.
- 4 (b) A vehicle purchased or leased in this state and delivered
- 5 to the purchaser or lessee by a dealer or by the owner of the
- 6 vehicle for removal to a place outside of this state, if a
- 7 certification is made that the vehicle will be primarily used,
- 8 stored, and registered outside of this state and will not be
- 9 returned to this state by the purchaser or lessee for use or
- 10 storage.
- 11 (10) A special registration issued under subsection (9) is
- 12 valid for not more than 30 days after the date of issuance, and a
- 13 fee shall be collected for each special registration as provided in
- 14 section 802(3). The special registration may be in the form
- 15 determined by the secretary of state. If a dealer makes a retail
- 16 sale or lease of a vehicle to a purchaser or lessee who is
- 17 qualified and eligible to obtain a special registration, the dealer
- 18 shall apply for the special registration for the purchaser or
- 19 lessee. If a person other than a dealer sells or leases a vehicle
- 20 to a purchaser or lessee who is qualified and eligible to obtain a
- 21 special registration, the purchaser or lessee shall appear in
- 22 person, or by a person exercising the purchaser's or lessee's power
- 23 of attorney, at an office of the secretary of state and furnish a
- 24 certification that the person is the bona fide purchaser or lessee
- 25 or that the person has granted the power of attorney, together with
- 26 other forms required for the issuance of the special registration
- 27 and provide the secretary of state with proof that the vehicle is

- 1 covered by a Michigan no-fault insurance policy issued pursuant to
- 2 section 3101 of the insurance code of 1956, 1956 PA 218, MCL
- 3 500.3101, or proof that the vehicle is covered by a policy of
- 4 insurance issued by an insurer pursuant to section 3163 of the
- 5 insurance code of 1956, 1956 PA 218, MCL 500.3163. The
- 6 certification required in this subsection shall contain all of the
- 7 following:
- 8 (a) The address of the purchaser or lessee.
- **9** (b) A statement that the vehicle is purchased or leased for
- 10 registration outside of this state.
- 11 (c) A statement that the vehicle shall be primarily used,
- 12 stored, and registered outside of this state.
- 13 (d) The name of the jurisdiction in which the vehicle is to be
- 14 registered.
- 15 (e) Other information requested by the secretary of state.
- 16 (11) In the case of a commercial vehicle, trailer, or
- 17 semitrailer issued a registration under the international
- 18 registration plan, the secretary of state in mutual agreement with
- 19 the owner may assign or reassign the expiration date of the
- 20 registration. However, the expiration date agreed to shall be
- 21 either March 31, June 30, September 30, or December 31. Renewals
- 22 expiring on or after September 30, 1993 shall be for a minimum of
- 23 at least 12 months if there is a change in the established
- 24 expiration date.
- 25 (12) The expiration date for a multiyear registration issued
- 26 for a leased vehicle shall be the date the lease expires but shall
- 27 not be for a period longer than 24 months.

- 1 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 2 after the date it is enacted into law.
