HOUSE BILL No. 5401

January 11, 2018, Introduced by Rep. Kosowski and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources.

A bill to amend 2016 PA 560, entitled "Michigan veterans' facility authority act," by amending section 6 (MCL 36.106).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 6. (1) The authority shall have all of the followingpowers:
- 3 (a) To solicit and accept gifts, grants, and loans from any4 person.
 - (b) To invest any money of the authority at the authority's discretion, in any obligations determined proper by the authority, and name and use depositories for its money.
 - (c) To procure insurance against any loss in connection with the property, assets, or activities of the authority.
 - (d) To sue and be sued, to have a seal, and to make, execute,

- 12 conferred upon it by any law, contract or other agreement.
- 13 (h) To engage the services of financial advisors and experts,

- 15 advisors, consultants, and fiduciaries as may be necessary to
- 16 effectuate the purposes of this act.
- 17 (i) To pay its operating expenses and financing costs.
- 18 (j) To pledge revenues or other assets as security for the
- 19 payment of the principal of and interest on any bonds.
- (k) To procure insurance, letters of credit, or other credit
- 21 enhancement with respect to any bonds for the payment of tenders of
- 22 bonds, or for the payment upon maturity of short-term bonds.

- 24 (m) To solicit federal funds and other funding sources to

- 2 (2) When hiring employees for a veterans' facility, the
- 3 authority shall give preference to employees currently employed by

- 6 (3) In determining the operation and staffing of a veterans'
- 7 facility, the authority shall do both of the following:
- 8 (a) Consider nationally recognized models and guidelines for
- 9 the delivery of health care in veterans' facilities.
- 10 (b) Follow rules and regulations of the civil service
- 11 commission.
- 12 (4) THE AUTHORITY SHALL CAUSE THE WATER AT EACH VETERANS'
- 13 FACILITY OPERATED BY THE AUTHORITY TO BE SAMPLED AND TESTED ON A
- 14 MONTHLY BASIS FOR THE PRESENCE OF LEAD AND ALL OTHER SUBSTANCES FOR
- 15 WHICH THERE IS A STATE DRINKING WATER STANDARD ESTABLISHED UNDER
- 16 THE SAFE DRINKING WATER ACT, 1976 PA 399, MCL 325.1001 TO 325.1023,
- 17 TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE WATER IS IN COMPLIANCE WITH THAT ACT.
