## **HOUSE BILL No. 5457**

January 30, 2018, Introduced by Rep. Cochran and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to designate the last Saturday in September as Public Lands Day in this state.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. (1) This state is home to 103 state parks and 2 recreation areas covering 306,000 acres with 314,100 campsites in 3 142 campgrounds and with over 900 miles of trails. These state 4 parks and recreation areas offer a range of activities from 5 traditional outdoor activities such as camping, hunting, and 6 fishing, to new and emerging activities such as mountain biking, 7 cross-country skiing, adventure racing, whitewater paddling, and playing water sports. This state is also home to 4 state forests, 9 encompassing over 3.8 million acres of land, that are managed for 10 resource protection, natural resource based economic activity, and

- 1 recreation. The acreage of state forest in this state is greater
- 2 than the acreage in any other state east of the Mississippi. In
- 3 recognition of the importance of federal, state, and local public
- 4 lands to the wildlife, recreation, and economy of this state, the
- 5 legislature declares that the last Saturday in September of each
- 6 year shall be known as "Public Lands Day".
- 7 (2) The legislature encourages individuals to engage in
- 8 activities on Public Lands Day that contribute to the conservation
- 9 of public lands in this state.
- 10 Enacting section 1. This act takes effect 90 days after the
- 11 date it is enacted into law.
- 12 Enacting section 2. This act does not take effect unless
- 13 Senate Bill No. or House Bill No. 5458 (request no. 03838'17) of
- 14 the 99th Legislature is enacted into law.
